Sustainable Cosmetic Product Development: Market, Regulation & Product Development

Instructor: Wen Schroeder, President, SEKI Cosmetics LLC

Course Summary: The consumer market has evolved over time along with the global green movement. Today's consumers are conscientious buyers who do not simply buy into a green image; they want to see proof that the manufacturers are engaged in business practices that would ensure a common, sustainable future for all, in both economic and ecological sense. In short, they demand reassurance and actual substantiation of sustainability. This course will provide an overview of this socio-economic trending and how it is shaping the behavior and practices of both consumers and manufacturers alike in cosmetic/personal care product development.

She is key expert for the ASEAN-EU Program for Regional Integration Support in cosmetic & pharmaceutical GMP and testing.
