



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
Educational Seminar on Advanced Skin Science

On September 10th, Dr. Randy Wickett presented a day-long seminar entitled "Advanced Skin Science". Randy has many years of experience in performing clinical and biophysical research on skin and hair at Procter & Gamble and the SC Johnson Company. In 1991, he joined the University of Cincinnati and is now Emeritus Professor of Pharmaceutics and Cosmetic Science in the College of Pharmacy.

The course provided a detailed review of skin structures and functions including aspects of skin biochemistry and molecular biology. In the morning session, Dr. Wickett presented a comprehensive review of the structure and functions of the epidermis and stratum corneum, which are the parts of the skin of most interest to cosmetic chemists. In the afternoon, Randy covered the topics of intrinsic skin aging and photo-aging, skin pigmentation, and skin cancer.
