Goring gap (North) Planning application

Eleven months after Persimmon's 'Consultation Meeting' with residents, a planning application for 475 dwellings on the northern gap, known as Chatsmore Farm has been sent to Worthing Borough Council. The dwellings are set out between the railway and the Rife.

The Goring Gap Action Group (GGAG) which is mainly composed of the Goring Residents' Association, The Goring & Ilex Conservation Group and The Ferring Conservation Society will be meeting together to plan how to mount the strongest opposition. The GRA will be posting updates on the website. We believe that this green space, which has been given Protected status in the Worthing Local Plan is worth fighting for. All Goring residents are encouraged to contact the Council to voice their views.
