About Our Club

The Michigan Treasure Hunters club has been active for over 45 years and is one of the largest clubs of its kind in the United States. Membership to our club comes with many annual "perks", such as private and club -sponsored hunts, giveaways and the ability to interact with over 1000 years of collective metal detecting experience from our current members. Guests are "Always" welcome!

Meetings and Events

Monthly Meetings: We meet monthly 11 months out of the year where we have a "Find of the month/year, various events planned such as an Open House, Ice Cream socials, swap meets, Bingo, and a Chili Cook off. We typically have guest speakers who talk about various metal detecting areas or history in the area. In addition, we have raffles for silver and other valuable prizes. The proceeds from one of the raffles goes to a charity selected by the club. During our Christmas meeting, we collect toys for Toys for Tots and make the donation for our charity raffle to the selected charity. We also have a drawing for a silver quarter for members in attendance and if you are wearing your club name tag, it's a fifty cent piece.

Token Hunts: We hold monthly token hunts typically March through November where a club token and silver coins of various denominations are planted. The club provides the initial seed money and monies collected from the hunt fees are planted back in the ground in the next hunt.

You must be a paid member to participate in the hunt. Dues can be paid at the hunt, or sent to the PO Box in advance.

If you are skilled enough (or lucky enough) to find the token that is also planted, you "get the honor" of selecting the location and planting the coins in the next hunt. Afterwards, you are awarded a silver dollar, typically at the next meeting when you announce the date and time for the next hunt.

Spring Warm-up Hunt - We have a hunt early in the season where a large quantity of coins (normally clad) and other prizes are planted. This gives everyone a chance to warm up their detecting skills. The warm-up hunt is free to members.

Fishbowl Hunt: During our indoor meetings, a fishbowl is passed around during the meeting and all monies collected are planted in the ground for a free hunt in the fall.

Can-Am Hunt: This year the Can-Am hunt will be at Stymelski park in Livonia. The hunt is open to all members and each hunter must have their own detector. There will be three hunts with the third one costing \$5 with more valuable targets. Note that this is also a pot luck so please bring a dish to pass.

Presidents Token: Joe Leblanc, a former club president, continues to hide "The President's Token". Clues are given as to its location during each meeting until it is found. When it is turned in, the finder is awarded a silver fifty cent piece and the token is replanted. In the past, the token has been found in fields in Livonia, Northville, Farmington Hills, Plymouth and Dixboro often near schools, as well as city parks. Look for the clues elsewhere in the future.

Fall Hunt: Every fall, a location is selected for a weekend hunt. Arrival is on Friday and hunting starts Saturday. You can also hunt Sunday if you want. The location is sent out a few days before the hunt. Food is provided Saturday and breakfast is provided on Sunday. Space is limited so sign up before all of the spots are taken.
