NOTICE OF VACANCY TO BE FILLED BY CO-OPTION

The Parish Council currently has a vacancy for a parish councillor.

Provided a person is 18 years of age or older on the day they become nominated for election and satisfies at least ONE of the following they may apply:

- They are registered as a local Government elector for the parish
- They have during the whole of the preceding twelve months occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the parish.
- Their principal place of work during the preceding 12 months has been in the parish
- They have during the whole of the preceding 12 months resided in the parish or within 4.8km (3 miles) of it.

The council may co-opt any person who is legally qualified to hold such office, and who is willing to serve provided they are a British citizen, a citizen of Ireland, a qualifying citizen of the Commonwealth or the European Union, and are neither the subject of a bankruptcy restriction order or interim order or have, within five years before the day of the election, been convicted in the United Kingdom of any offence and have had a prison sentence (whether suspended or not) for a period of over three months without the option of a fine.
