



## Texas Leontix Boerboels Puppy Questionnaire

Thank you for your interest in Texas Leontix Boerboels. We are very proud of our Boerboels, and believe they represent some of the best qualities of the breed; excellent temperament, good health, wonderful family companions and conformation to the breed. Each of our Boerboels have been carefully chosen and lovingly raised as part of our family in our home. As we plan our breeding's, consideration is given to careful selection of a suitable mate. Considerations including confirmation including weak and strong qualities, pigment, color, athleticism, and movement are all included. Our goal is to improve upon the breed as best we can. We love Boerboels and want you to love them as well.

We will let our puppies go to their new homes between 8 –9 weeks of age providing each one is growing steadily and is cleared by our veterinarian as healthy and ready to travel. Before leaving our home, they will have their first vaccinations, be wormed multiple times with prescription wormer, tails docked, rear dew claws removed if present, and micro-chipped. You will receive a complete vaccine and health record with your puppy from a licensed veterinarian.

Because we are responsible breeders who care deeply for our dogs, puppies and the Boerboel breed, we are committed to finding the best homes for our puppies. Below is a series of questions that will help us determine homes where our puppies will be able to reach their full potential. There are no right or wrong answers to these questions. Your answers will help us determine which puppy is more suitable for a particular home.

If you are interested in a puppy from Texas Leontix Boerboels please read these questions carefully and answer them in as much detail as possible. Thank you.

1. Boerboels are a rare breed. How did you find out about them?

3. Have you ever met a Boerboel?

5. Do you have experience with giant breeds or guardian breeds? If so, explain.
6. What activities have you done with your dogs (please list all, competitive or not)?
7. If you are married or share your home with another person(s) do they support adding a Boerboel to your family?
8. Do you have children living at home?
  - a. If yes, what ages are they?
9. Do you currently have other pets?
  - a. If yes, what are they and are they spayed or neutered?
10. Do you live in a rural or suburban setting?
11. What facilities do you have for protecting and sheltering a Boerboel? (i.e.: fenced yard? kennel? dog house? crate? room in your home?)
12. Where will your dog live?
  - a. While you are at work?
  - b. At night, while you sleep?

13. What will a typical day be like for your family dog?
14. How many hours a day will the dog typically be left alone?
15. Boerboels must have formal and informal obedience training/socialization starting as soon as you get them home (puppies may begin attending classes as soon as they have completed their second set of immunizations). Be sure any program you choose utilizes “**positive reinforcement**” in their training. Are you planning on taking your puppy through a training program?
16. Do you have specific training goals for your puppy (agility, carting, weight pull, obedience, etc.)?
17. Are you currently a member of SABBS, NABBA, or AKC? If so, which one?
18. Do you have any intention of showing this puppy? If so, in what organization and event?
19. Do you have any intention of breeding this puppy? If so, at what age will you begin? (If the answer to this question is no, please skip to question #24)

ALL PUPPIES ARE SOLD WITH PET ONLY REGISTRATIONS. FEMALES WILL NOT BE PLACED WITH BREEDERS THAT DO NOT HAVE AN ESTABLISHED BREEDING HISTORY. THIS BREEDING HISTORY MUST HAVE SIMILAR GOALS TO OUR OWN. QUALITY OF LIFE IS MOST IMPORTANT TO US WHEN PLACING OUR PUPPIES. IN THE CASE OF A MALE PUP BREEDING RIGHTS CAN BE OFFERED TO SELECT HOMES BUT ALL PUPS MUST FIRST BE APPRAISED BY SABBS or NABBA WITH A MINIMUM OF A 75% SCORE. IN ADDITION, HEALTH TESTING IS REQUIRED FOR HIP, ELBOW, AND CARDIAC CONDITIONS. TESTING MUST BE BY A LICENSED VETERINARIAN AND CERTIFIED BY OFA OR PENNHIP BEFORE A DOG IS BRED. ONCE THESE RESULTS ARE SUBMITTED TO LEONTIX BOERBOELS REGISTRATION CAN BE CHANGED TO FULL BREEDING RIGHTS IN THE CASE OF A MALE PUP. THIS POLICY IS TO ENSURE THAT THE QUALITY OF OUR LINE IS NOT DISRUPTED.

**NO BREEDING TO MIXED BREEDS OR NON-BOERBOELS WILL BE PERMITTED.**

Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee the number of puppies our girls will have or the gender or color of the puppies. What we can guarantee is that the puppies will be loved and nurtured right along with our own dogs. They will receive the same quality care and devotion here that we expect they will be able to depend and thrive on when they reach their new homes. Once your application is reviewed and approved please send your \$500 deposit. Between 7-8 weeks we will finalize picks based on conformation and temperament in an attempt to ensure that the correct puppy goes to the right home. Balance is due at pick up or upon the puppy turning 8 weeks old. If you are unable to pick up your puppy by 9 weeks boarding fees will apply. Final payments need to be in cash, Zelle, or Venmo. If you choose to use PayPal a 3% fee will be added to your transaction.
