Privacy Policy

This privacy policy explains how The Audio Biographers uses the personal data that we collect from you when you use our website.

The Audio Biographers are committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide any information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

The Audio Biographers may change this policy from time to time by updating this document. You should check this document regularly to ensure you are happy with any changes. This privacy policy was last updated on 7 October 2019.

What data do we collect?

The personal information we collect may include your; name, address, postcode, phone numbers, email address, IP address, and information regarding what pages are accessed and when. We will not collect, store or process data that is labelled as sensitive under GDPR.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide The Audio Biographers with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Voluntarily complete an enquiry form on our website.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, in particular for the following reasons: to carry out our obligations arising from any enquiries, projects or contracts entered into by you and us, compliance with a legal obligation, vital interests, a public task or legitimate interests.

Internal record keeping

- We may use the information to improve our products and services.
- We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.
- We may collect IP addresses of visitors to our website for the purposes of protecting our website from hacking attempts or email SPAM.
- We may collect and store personal data as part of web servers' logs for the purposes of detecting and preventing fraud and unauthorised access and maintaining the security of our systems.

Marketing

- The Audio Biographers would periodically like to send you promotional emails about new products, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting using the email address which you have provided.
- We may contact you by email, phone or mail.
- You have the right at any time to stop The Audio Biographers from contacting you for marketing purposes.

How long do we keep your data for?

We will hold your personal information on our systems for as long as is necessary for the relevant activity, or as long as is set out in any relevant contract you hold with us. We review our retention periods for personal information on a regular basis.

What are your data protection rights?

Under the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), you have the following rights:

- The right to be informed You have the right to be informed about the collection and use of your personal data.
- The right of access You have the right to request The Audio Biographers for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.
- The right to rectification You have the right to request that The Audio Biographers correct any information your believe to be inaccurate. You also have the right to request The Audio Biographers to complete any information you believe to be incomplete.
- The right to erasure You have the right to request that The Audio Biographers erase your personal data under certain conditions.
- The right to restrict processing You have the right to request that The Audio Biographers restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to object to processing You have the right to object to The Audio Biographers processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to data portability You have the right to request that The Audio Biographers transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
- The right to object You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.
- The right not to be subject to automated decision-making including profiling You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated means.

 aspects of this data with third parties for advertising purposes. We may also share online data
 collected through cookies with our advertising partners. This means that when you visit another
