

Position – Bulldog Program League Representative

Position Summary

As a program league representative, you have the responsibility to serve as the primary liaison between the Morris County Youth Football League (MCYFL) board and league committee and the Randolph Bulldog program. Your role is one that will communicate with and represent the decisions/positions of the Bulldog Board.

You may also be assigned as League Board support to League Committee - sub committees on various topics and discussions.

League Representative is a Bulldog Committee member.

League Representative will participate in a monthly MCYFL Meeting, typically the first Wednesday of each month.

League Representative will participate in the monthly Bulldog Committee meetings and round table. You will report on meeting activities, proposed rule and by-law changes, and outstanding invoices owed to the MCYFL.

League Representative will consult with the Bulldog Committee to educate or intake feedback of the overall Bulldog program and vote in accordance with Bulldog Committee position on any action, bylaw, or rule.

League Representative will present Bulldog program recommended MCYFL by-law or rule changes as needed at MCFFL meeting.

League Representative will coordinate with the Bulldog Board, Bulldog Head Coaches, and team General Managers to assemble the roster book for each team. He/she will present the Randolph roster books at the League annual roster meeting.

Required Qualifications

- Willingness to volunteer
- Collaborator working with the Program Director, Board, Committee, Families and Players
- Have an understanding of the Football program – League, Recreation Department, Bulldogs rules/policies and procedures
- Have an understanding of Morris County Youth Football League by-laws, rules, and procedures.
- Willingness to serve which includes having discussions with many different stakeholder groups.
- Willing to educate others in the program about the rules/policies/procedures which are not clear to all.

Program Overview
