

## **Position – Bulldog Program Committee Member**

### **Position Summary**

As a program board member, you have the responsibility to provide vision, scope, organization and oversight to the overall program. Your role is one that will make decisions with the alignment of the other board members, and you will also be assigned as Board support to Committee sub committees.

Board members are typically adults that do not have kids in the program which helps all the board member to support the program in a way that is not encumbered by having a player in the program.

As board member, you will work and collaborate with the Committee members to help in the overall execution of the program.

The board is made up of:

- Program Director - Chairperson
- Program Operations Lead
- Treasurer
- “X” Board Members at Large
- Honorary Member - High School Head Football Coach
- Honorary Member – Recreation Department Director/Asst Director Representative

Board members are assigned across many different Board Committees as support or oversight – these are limited to the following:

- Coaches Committee
- Grievance Committee
- League Representation Committee
- Treasurer and Audit Sub Committees
- Program Scheduling
- Sponsorship and Snack Shack Sub Committees
- Equipment Modernization / Replacement and Co-op Bid input
- Major Events committee(s) as needed
- Major Capital Project Committee(s) as needed

Board members will participate in a monthly Board meeting which works on over program direction and takes Committee, League, Rec Department and Bulldog Family feedback and input to help in the overall guidance of Bulldog program.

Board members will participate in the monthly Committee meetings and round table, working with the committee to help educate and take feedback in support of the overall Bulldog program.

Board members prioritizes capital projects, manages financial risk based treasury review.

Board members help make suggestions to the League Representative Sub Committee when it comes to league rule changes, policy and procedure.

### **Required Qualifications**

- Willingness to volunteer
- Collaborator working with the Program Director, Board, Committee, Families and Players
- Have an understanding of the Football program – League, Recreation Department, Bulldogs rules/policies and procedures – or a willingness to learn.
- Willingness to lead as a Board member which includes having discussions with many different stakeholder groups.
- Willing to educate others in the program about the rules/policies/procedures which are not clear to all.
- Wanting to learn about the nuances and balance between League, Recreation Department and Program and creating communication that brings these often-differing goals together in support of the 300 plus players and their families
