Position Summary

As a committee member, you will work with the Program Board to take on specific support roles or work on a needed Sub Committee to help in thought leadership and organization of activities and or events.

Program Committee members are additional voices to provide feedback and input into the Bulldogs Program. Committee member role is a great place to get started in support of the Bulldogs program as it will provide learning opportunities and understanding of all the moving parts of the program.

Participate in monthly Committee meetings, about 1.5 – 2 hours in length. You will be a part of the hearing the vision, controls and program needs, and you will have the opportunity to participate in projects which support the program.

You will have an opportunity to actively engage in the Committee Roundtable discussions, learn how different policies, alignment of rules and procedures limit how the program can operate. (Town Recreation and MCYFL). Your strength is in looking for ways to move projects forward, operating within these boundaries of the rules/policies of Program, Rec Department and League.

The Committee is made up of Volunteers, Head Coaches and Bulldog Board. We operate with the viewpoint it takes a “village” – so the Committee plays an important role in support and executing ideas into action/delivery.

Committee members have the flexibility to get involved in projects that they are passionate about – which brings more action and support because we are all in when it comes to the program. “An engaged committee member is a needed committee member!”

As a committee member, you may be called on in season to help with a challenge the program is facing, you will be leaned on, in the sense of being asked for help so we can drive success.

Required Qualifications

- Have an understanding that the Committee role is all about understanding boundaries and have a willingness to adapt with the intention to do the best we can for program.
- Be a collaborator – willing to listen, learn and support the program – even when things are frustrating, and we hit roadblocks.
- Able to take Ideas into actions – working with others to bring ideas to delivery
- Willingness to work with the program board, coaches, other committee members, in support of special projects and events.

- Wanting to learn about the nuances and balance between League, Recreation Department and Program and creating communication that brings these often-differing goals together in support of the 300 plus players and their families
