You will create, manage, report and highlight risks for the annual booster budget, this includes a monthly treasurer report presented to the Board and reviewed at the Committee meeting.

You will also work the Recreation Department Booster Treasurer in making sure that Program Books and Rec Booster Books are aligned. You will also be involved in program modeling for suggested changes in program registration costs, equipment maintenance and replacement modeling and program purchasing outside of the Recreation Department purchases.

Work with the following Committees to make sure there is controls and reporting for and not limited to:

- Snack Shack
- Sponsorship
- Fund Raising Events
- Yearbook

Organize the list of Capital Projects for the program based on the collection of needs and suggestions from Board, Committee, Coaches and parents. Creating a backlog of potential projects with estimated cost. The Board will prioritize capital projects for the year based on available funds and need(s) of the program.

You will organize a quarterly review of the Booster Books, Controls of income collections and provide feedback on the quarterly audit of the Football book against the transactional file provided by the Rec Booster Treasurer. This review is done with the Bulldog Audit Sub committee for checks and balances.
