

REGISTERING A DEATH

After a loved one has passed away, the doctor will send the MCCD (Medical Certificate Of Cause Of Death) to the registrar via email. Following this, you will need to call the relevant registrar to make an appointment to attend their office and register the death. This process may take two or three days. We are here to help and advise with this process.

You will need to know how many death certificates will be required as these will be requested for any pension claims, insurance policies, banks, building societies and solicitors, if appointed.

Certificates are £11 each and will be sent out to you in the post first class. If you require duplicates they are also £11. We do not need a copy of the certificate from you.

When the Registrar calls you will need:

- Full name of deceased
- Place and date where the death occurred
- Home address
- Occupation
- Marital status
- Maiden name
- Spouse full name and occupation
- NI number if known
- NHS number if known

'TELL US ONCE'

Tell Us Once is a service that the Registrar will inform you of when you register your loved ones passing. The Registrar will allocate your loved one a unique number and send this information by email or in the post with your death certificates. Once you receive these, contact the service and give them the unique number. You must use the service within 28 days of getting your unique reference number. Your loved ones information will then appear on their screen and they will cancel anything government related that your loved one has in their name. This will save you many phone

Before you use this service, you will need the following details of the deceased.

- name
- date of birth
- address
- date they died

- name, address and contact details of the person or company dealing with their estate (property, belongings and money), known as their 'executor' or 'administrator'
- if there's a surviving spouse or civil partner, the name, address, telephone number and the National Insurance number or date of birth of the spouse or civil partner
- if there's no surviving spouse or civil partner or their spouse or civil partner is not able to deal with their affairs, the name and address of their next of kin
- if they died in a hospital, nursing home, care home or hospice, the name and address of that institution - you'll also be asked if the stay was for 28 days or more

You'll also need:

- if they had a passport, their passport number and town of birth
- if they had a driving licence, their driving licence number
- if they owned any vehicles, the vehicle registration numbers
- if they were getting services from their local council, such as Housing Benefit payments or Council Tax reductions, the name of their local council and which services they were getting
- if they were getting any benefits, tax credits or State Pension, information about which ones they were getting
- if they were getting money from an Armed Forces Pension or Compensation Scheme, details of that scheme

USING A SOLICITOR

Most people use a solicitor to apply for probate and administer an estate. The executor or the nearest relative can instruct a solicitor and the legal costs can be paid from the estate.

These legal costs are a legitimate expense and any executor or administrator are able to do this. As property values increase, it is important to claim all of the available allowances so that Inheritance Tax is minimised. The addition of the Residence Nil Rate band in April 2017 has added another level of complexity to administering an estate. Specialist solicitors are used to dealing with deceased estates and have relevant knowledge of the law and the tax implications.
