Matthew 10:37-4 Pointers for Prayer

- 1. Jesus never wanted suffering for anyone but he knew that if anyone was going to follow in his footsteps promoting love and respect for every person, they would meet with opposition. Fidelity has its price, but also rewards. Would you agree?
- 2. The passage is a call to both radical and practical discipleship. When have you found that in order to achieve a certain objective you had to make it a priority and then take the practical steps necessary to reach your goal? What were the benefits to you when you did this?
- 3. 'Hate' (in the Lucan version) is prophetic exaggeration for the uncompromising loyalty Jesus seeks in disciples. There may be times when people make demands in conflict with fidelity to another relationship. This can be painful. When have you found that being clear about your priorities helped you in that situation?

"These last few weeks I have had the privilege of facilitating 4 workshops with priests from across the archdiocese. The aim of these meetings was to help them explore their on-going formation needs and

ways in which they can better work together. This is in response to Synod Recommendation #3. During one of these workshops, I was reminded of the word of St Francis de Sales:

"Have patience with all things, but chiefly have patience with yourself. Do not lose courage in considering your own imperfections, but instead set about remedying them, every day begin the task anew."

It has been humbling to work with people who have dedicated their lives to Christ, who also are reaching out for support from both the Church and the laity. Let us pray for them, Fr Grant and the Inch Group, as they enable new relationships to emerge and open the possibility of new ways of being church."

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process given to us by the Church to initiate adults and older children into Christianity as it is lived within the Roman Catholic tradition.

It is the way in which we welcome and share with others our faith and our way of life as Catholics. It is a process, a journey of faith, by which we engage with those who are seeking the face of Christ today.

The Rite tells us that it 'is suited to a spiritual journey of adults that varies according to the many forms of God's grace'. It involves the whole parish and is the responsibility of all the baptised.

Each year there are people who enquire about becoming a Catholic, often with no previous religious affiliation. They are accompanied by RCIA teams who guide them through the different stages of the RCIA process and prepare them to celebrate the liturgies which mark these stages.

We welcome inquiries from everyone. You may be someone who has never belonged to any faith tradition or you may have been baptised in another Christian faith. You may simply feel a sense of curiosity to find out more or you may have already decided to seek membership of the Catholic Church.
