From the Club Governor:

Regarding NCCC and Regional changes, clubs can hold 14 sanction events per year now.

Concourse and Car Shows will be separate events: Concourse will be individually judged classes by the Concourse judging rules. Car Shows will be participant voting or people's choice events with no judging involved.

In Concourse judging, Best of Show judging engine will not be considered due to being unable to see engines in C8 Convertibles. For NCCC members, the NCCC Members only password is 2024E-Ray.

Only NCCC members would have this legal protection and liability coverage per our insurance carrier.

Spouse membership includes spouse, significant others, or main squeeze.
