

Show Guidelines & Rules for 2023 Events

- 1. All classes are open to everyone meeting the criteria listed for the class you need not be an affiliated club member to participate! Sunshine Horse Show Series rules will be observed in all classes unless noted. Rulebooks are available on-line at www.ssshowseries.com or at the entry booth for inspection. For more information call/text show secretary Celeste O'Neill 518-466-2445 or show manager Linda Voehringer 518-577-3387/cell.
- 2. Horse Show Awards: Leadline classes receive award & ribbons for all. Equitation Classes for 17 yrs & Under receive award (if sponsored) & ribbons. Walk/Trot and all other Junior Exhibitor classes: 6 ribbons. All other horse show classes: Payback & 6 ribbons; paybacks sweepstaked if less than 10 entries and payback vouchers must be redeemed within 30 minutes of the end of the show no exceptions! Show Champions & Reserve Champions for the weekend are also awarded in specified divisions! Must enter in at least 3 classes in the division to be eligible for championship awards. Championships awarded in divisions that have at least 3 entries, unless sponsored. Ties broken at the discretion of show management. Classes that count are posted in prize list and any updates/changes will be posted on show day at entry stand. Awards will be forfeited if you are not present to accept. Show does not mail awards and show does not bring your award to the next show for you to pick up.
- 3. Fees: indicated on entry form. To be considered as a "Pre-Entry" entries must be submitted by pre-entry deadline, include all necessary signatures and health paperwork and <u>must include</u> a "signed" check payable to Classic Country Horse Association or must be paid for in full via paypal using the "friends & family" option to teamassmann@live.com by deadline. If the "friends & family" option is not selected, your entry will not be processed and you will have to pay post entry fees. The pre-entries must be postmarked by the Saturday <u>before</u> the show weekend. Post entries accepted at the show at \$2/per class in addition to regular class fees.New for 2023: Pre-entry flat fee as indicated on entry form. This flat fee is for horse/rider combination.
- 4. Classes must be paid for as entered or a signed blank check left at the entry booth. Office Fee of \$7 per each horse/rider combination and grounds fee of \$5/day for non-stabled showing equines. Pre-Entries received without a "signed" check payable to Classic Country Horse Association, or not paid via paypal with the "friends & family" option will not be considered for pre-entry.
- 5. Health Paperwork: All entries must have a legible, current New York State (2022 or '23) coggins and current rabies certificate available for inspection before back numbers are issued. Coggins & Rabies certificate MUST be legible if we can't read it, you will not be allowed to show no exceptions. If you would like, include a legible copy with your entry.
- **6.** Each horse-rider combination must use a separate entry form. Each entry form must have the release statement signed by the exhibitor or a parent or legal guardian if the exhibitor is under 18 years of age. Failure to wear the correct number in a class or to sign the release statement will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees for that class, forfeiting all prize money, awards, day end and Sunshine Horse Show Series points.
- 7. The show committee reserves the right to change, move, combine, add or cancel classes as warranted, decline or refuse an entry at this show without being held liable; eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or equine should the best interest of the show be served. Corrections to the prize list will be posted in the secretary's stand. The horse show <u>judges' decision is final</u> and he/she has the right to dismiss any entry displaying unruliness or unsoundness in their opinion. All inquires to the judge must be made through the show office. Exhibitors or agents making inquires directly to the judge will be disqualified and no refunds issued. Please request tack holds from the announcer.
- 8. Returned Checks: A \$50 charge for nonnegotiable checks if payment is made within 7 days of notification, \$75 thereafter. This is in addition to any bank fees, collection fees and the value of the check. Participation in future events will be barred until outstanding fees are paid. Exhibitors with nonnegotiable checks will have checks posted at the show as well as in future prize lists. According to the NYS General Obligations Law, Section 11-104: if your check bounces you could be liable for the face value of the check, plus two times the amount of the check, up to \$400 for a check dishonored due to insufficient funds, and up to \$750 for checks drawn on a nonexisting account. Bad check writers may also face criminal penalties.
- 9. Refunds: Pre-entry stall (or pre-entry grounds fees) and class fees will be refunded, only if a request in writing and an authentic veterinary certificate are received by show manager no later than 6 P.M. on show day. All other fees are nonrefundable. All entered classes will be charged to the exhibitor regardless of scratches. Any changes to classes, exhibitor or equine will be treated as a new entry.

Show Guidelines & Rules for 2023 Events, continued

- **10.** Age: **Exhibitors/Equine age** is as of January 1, 2023. All riders 17 years of age and under <u>must</u> wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard per NY State Law No. VAT1265.
- 11. ◆ symbol denotes classes that are not pointed with Sunshine Horse Show Series. Some of these include: Maiden classes are open to anyone who has NOT won a blue ribbon in this type of class. Maiden classes are non-pointed. Schooling WT Pleasure - a non-pointed class open to anyone regardless if you show WTC. See Sunshine Horse Show Series Rule Book for more specifics.

Youth classes - non-pointed classes open to exhibitors 17 years of age and Under.

<u>Pairs</u> class - grab a horse show friend - judged on ability of the pair of equines to perform together as a matched pair for pleasure riding. This is a 2-gait class. Exhibitors that WTC can also participate without penalty.

- 12. Stalls exhibitors must post the index card on the DOOR of stall and/or camper that the club provides. Stalls available Friday <u>after</u> 2:00 PM and must be vacated within 2 hours of the conclusion of the show unless other arrangements with show management have been made. Stalls are rented for the day. If you are found without your stall door tagged, you will be charged double. Bedding is not provided. Stalls assigned through show secretary. All manure must be placed in designated area.
- 13. Campers (starting after 3pm on fridays and must leave within 2 hours of the conclusion of the show). New Cobleskill Fairground Rules for 2023: If campers (& horse trailers) do not want to be charged they will have to park in the infield where there is NO hookups. Exhibitors must post the index card (club provides) on the DOOR of your camper. If you are found without your Camper tagged, you will be charged double. Failure to pay camper fee will result in forfiture of points/awards for event. All campers must follow Cobleskill Agricultural Society's camping rules. IF you park near the barns w/o plugging in, you will be charged camper fee (sorry this is fairground rule). If you run a lead cord from one camper to another, you will be charged double for BOTH. Fairground Camper rules include: Camping limited to event participants on first come first serve bases and must park in designated areas. No one under 18 allowed to stay in a camper without adult supervision. All holding tanks must be closed. No dumping of waste water (gray water) througout the time the camper is on the grounds. The fairgrounds has 2 dumping stations. Leash laws are in effect for dogs. No dogs to be housed in stalls. No tents allowed on grounds. No tents allowed in stalls. No one is allowed to sleep in stalls. A separation distance of at least 10 feet must be maintained between camping units, including any add-on structures attached to the camping units including awnings and any structure. Also vehichles & trailers must be 10 feet from buildings. Charcoal grills, gas grills or other open flame cooking devices cannot be used within 10 feet of any camping unit and buildings. Bonfires or recreational fires are prohibited on the grounds. The camper registrant is responsible for any fine or violation imposed by the County Health Department. Limited electric hookups available. No generators are provided.
- **14. Other**: <u>Dogs</u> on the show grounds <u>must be</u> leashed at all times. For safety purposes, dogs should not be near the show ring or gate areas. Owners of aggressive or nuisance dogs (as determined by show management) will be asked to remove them from the show grounds. No entry fees will be refunded. No dogs to be housed in stalls.

Non-showing Equines: Any horse on the grounds but not entered in a class will be charged \$5 for each day on the grounds plus grounds fee or stall fee. Coggins & Rabies will be checked, a release must be signed and if using a stall, stall fee must be paid.
