Norchester Pool Rules

- 1. Proper pool identification is required for persons entering the pool area.
- 2. No loitering-the pool is for swimmers and their guardians only.
- 3. National lightning safety institute guidelines will be followed for rain/thunder/lightning
- 4. There will be a ten(10) minute rest period at the end of each hour for all swimmers.
- 5. The wading pool is for children up to five (5) years old and must be accompanied and supervised by an adult eighteen (18) years or older at all times.
- 6. Parents/guardians are responsible for the actions of their children and guests at the pool.
- 7. Children twelve (12) years of age and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult Eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- 8. Proper swim attire is required. No cut-offs, shirts or shoes allowed in the pool.
- 9. No bicycles, skateboards or other vehicles allowed in the pool area.
- 10. No loud, abusive or foul language will be tolerated.
- 11. No glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed in the pool area.
- 12. No diving allowed except from the diving board.
- 13. No electrical cords allowed.
- 14. No running horseplay, dunking, splashing or rough housing allowed.
- 15. Flotation devices are allowed only at the discretion of the lifeguards. These devices may be prohibited during crowded conditions or when considered a safety hazard.
- 16. No pets allowed in the pool area.
- 17. The lifeguards on duty have full & final authority concerning pool matters.
- 18. Failure to follow these rules may result in immediate removal from the pool.
- 19. Use of the pool is a privilege and may be suspended and/or revoked at any time if abused.
