

Since we introduced our 2022 "Rescue the Perishing" theme at our October 2021 Scripture Conference, the spiritual, moral and economic condition of our country has continued to disintegrate rapidly, leaving most Christians, myself included to believe that unless the Lord intervenes, His return could be much nearer than we have previously thought! While most of us, as we should be, are praying, interceding to the Lord for a Heaven sent, Holy Spirit filled, nationwide revival for America. I'm afraid that most Christians have forgotten that II Chronicles 7:14 gives us some prerequisites that we, the Church must meet before revival can come. Sadly, we do not see any movement in that direction, no humbling, little praying and seeking God's face and little if any turning from our wicked ways so how could we ever expect God to forgive our sins and heal our land, at least not in this country!

We occasionally hear of a few isolated outbreaks here in the states and while there have been some great awakenings in some foreign countries recently with great multitudes of thousands being saved, but few in America, a few flickers, and a little smoke maybe but no visible flames of revival. We all know the verse, "if my people" which are called by my name..., it's not the devil and his crowd that are hindering revival it's "God's people" the "Church"! With all of the signs of the time pointing to Jesus' return most evangelical churches including Independent Baptists are as cold as an old hound dog's nose on a bitter cold December winter's night!

We know all of the other verses too, all of the Old and New Testament prophecies concerning Jesus' return but like the people who Peter was speaking to in II Peter 3:4, if not in word, in their action most Christians are saying, "Where is the promise of his coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation." To which Peter answers in verse 5, "For this they willingly are ignorant of..." And in vs 8, says "But, beloved, be not ignorant

of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day." In verse 9, he reassures the people that the Lord will keep his promise just that he "...is longsuffering not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

There is a little chorus written by Dr. John R. Rice that I remember from my early years of vacation Bible school, "Jesus is coming is coming is coming, it may be tomorrow it may be today, may be the trumpet sound may be the angel's shout, then come up higher the Saviour will say!" Don't give up hope dear friends for Jesus is coming. It's just that His watch is on "God's standard time" and while we are seating around disregarding and disagreeing about the signs of the times, millions are perishing never hearing a clear presentation of the Gospel or ever possessing a copy of His written Word!

John 3:15 & 16, two of the best known and most often quoted verses in the Bible address the matter of those who are perishing without Christ! Verse 15, "That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life." and verse 16, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." In Luke 13, verses 3 and 5 which are exactly the same Jesus said, "I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." Considering that Jesus never wasted words it just might be that He was repeating the verse to emphasize the importance of His message!

Sister Fanny J. Crosby's song "Rescue the Perishing" is a call to Christians to the Church's responsibility to world evangelism and the great commission when she says, "Rescue the perishing, care for the dying, Snatch them in pity from sin and the grave; Weep o'er the erring ones, Lift up the fallen, Tell them of Jesus the mighty to save. Verse four says Rescue the

"Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear" (Hebrews 11:3). The Spoken Word of God...Its power is immeasurable. By the verbal Word of God, the stars were scattered in their fiery majesties, the oceans were poured in tumultuous waves of wonder, and all creatures were created as demonstrative reminders of that authoritative Word. Everyone gave him the same name of a man who stayed drunk, cursing everyone who walked by, and even abusing his own family. The preacher

went to the house to meet this repugnant man. Upon arriving, the missionary quickly realized he was drunk. He sternly asked the man to sober up because he would be returning the following morning to speak with him about something incredibly important. When he returned the next day, he was thankfully surprised to find the man had sobered up and was willing to speak with him. Gloriously, this man with the most horrible reputation was saved by the grace of God! His family was no longer in danger, the village people no longer afraid, and drunkenness and cursing nevermore a commonplace in his life.

After a couple weeks soulwinning, the Preacher was heading back home and want-

ed to say goodbye to his new Brother in Christ. However, the gentleman was not at his home. His neighbor told the Preacher where to find him. "In the jungle?" the missionary questioned. After several hours trekking through the rain forest, the Pastor was stunned to finally find the man with a water buffalo and chainsaw, creating a path. "I'm going to build a Church back here, Preacher!" the new Brazilian Believer enthusiastically yelled. With tears, the missionary inquired, "Really? That's wonderful! Why back here in the jungle? Why all the trouble?" Smiling from ear to ear, the determined Christian answered, "There are people back here that still need the Word of God. I served the devil with all that I had; I will not do any less for my Saviour."

Salvation is not found in any other. Sharper than a two-edged sword, the Word of God cuts through the toughest of skin, crumbles the hardest of hearts, and transcends every barrier with the power of the Gospel. We are called to rescue the perishing, and we can do so by sending this powerful Word to the regions beyond. Their lives are shattered, in need of the saving grace of Jesus that transforms and makes all things new. Will you and your Church send the powerful Word of God to those in need?

Production, Distribution and Financial Reports

In a one-sentence summary, we can say that God has been faithful! Good, yes, but good is relative, a matter of opinion, "faithful" is absolute, meaning He has done everything He said He would do and more! God amazes me all the time! When we stepped out by faith and started purchasing all the paper we needed to keep our web press running all the time every day, God gave us a more productive web press operator that could print three trailer loads of paper a month! Then when we started purchasing three trailer loads a month, He supplied the funds to pay for them since March of last year until the paper mill

limited us to two in May and June of this year; that's what I call faithful!



In June, the paper mill informed us of another large price increase effective August 1, so we ordered six trailer loads for July to make up for what they shorted us in May and June and to save a few dollars before the August 1 price increase. To add insult to injury, the paper mill without a notice or warning decided to delay making the paper by two weeks causing

us to be down several weeks without paper. The bill for these six trailer loads is \$252,000, about 5 times the monthly support that this ministry receives! It is exciting to see the Lord provide for the needs of this ministry; it does keep me awake some nights but He always comes through!

Those of us on the giving end of this ministry might be tempted sometimes

to ask if the fruit produced is worth the investment it requires but this is a foolish question as it is not our place to justify the cost as the decision is not ours to make, only our responsibility to obey. From where I sit however I can unequivocally and emphatically say yes, absolutely, even if it were only one person out of fifty million Bibles. I am confident, however based on the response that we receive from the missionaries and national pastors distributing these Scriptures, that mil-



lions have been saved, only God knows! Maybe we will find out when we get to Heaven, but should this be the case, I believe we will all be devastated and embarrassed that we had not done more and given more so that we could have reached more people than we have!

Through August 20th of this year, we received 25 trailer loads of paper, paid for 19 of them, consumed 20 trailer loads producing 1.6 million Bibles and Scriptures shipping 1,567,057 of them in 17 containers with sufficient finished and left over to fill over two more containers. A total of 18 languages going to 29 different countries. Of the 1.75 million Scriptures produced, 500,000 are



Ukrainian New Testaments, 212,000 are in the process of being distributed in the Ukraine and Romania, another 90,000 in transit, 50,000 more finished and ready to ship with 150,000 sets of signatures in the process of being collated and bound!

Of these 17 containers shipped 6 of them went to 5 countries in Africa, 1 to Honduras, 1 truck load to Mexico, 3 to different cities in the Philippines, 1 to

Pakistan, 1 to Australia, 1 to Myanmar, 3 to Poland & the Ukraine. Of the 2 ready to ship, 1 is going to Honduras/Central America and 1 to Kenya, leaving us with commitments to fill and ship 10 more containers this year: one each of Arabic Bibles, French Bibles, Urdu/English Bi-lingual Bible, Pidgin English N.T.'s English Bibles and five more Ukrainian N.Ts.

As of August 25, we had received \$1,443,733.57 designated for paper and Scripture productions spending \$1,472,690.14 to produce 1.6 million Bibles & Scriptures, \$750,585.50 of this for Bible paper with an unpaid paper bill of \$252,000 due in September for the six trailer loads of paper received in August.





The Bible Literature Missionary Foundation! I can't hardly put into words what this ministry has done for me personally, as well as our church family. Home Line Baptist Church of Midland, Texas has been transformed by this ministry.

"EXPERIENCE" say; the Scripture Conference, because it is a wonderful EXPERIENCE! The preaching is incredible, the Spirit is moving, the fellowship is wonderful, the music is touching, the food is second to none, and the Bible Barn will melt your heart. To "EXPERIENCE" seeing the printed Words of God coming off the press is like no other "EXPERIENCE" you can imagine. Of course, you must have a love for the Word of God to understand. A simple roll of white paper at the beginning of the web press miraculously comes out as the Words of God in printed form is just captivating! WOW! I am reminded of John 1:1 where Scripture says; "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." The "EXPERIENCE" of walking into the Bible Barn and seeing it all begin with a roll of plain paper, then to watch the final cut and

cover, is like "EXPERIENCING" the presence of God, and literally feeling "God with us." I wept, the first time I "EXPERIENCED" it.

If you have never attended our annual conference, you should do everything you can to "EXPERIENCE " it this year. We were honored to have Dr. David Gibbs, Jr. as our guest speaker last year, and as it turns out, we will have that same honor again this year! God has certainly gifted Dr. Gibbs with the ability to touch the heart of man, pull you into an illustration, make you feel like you are right there, and make you walk away with a desire to take on Hell with a squirt gun. I always leave challenged, convicted, and charged up. Of course, we will have many other great men of God preaching for us as well. There will be no shortage of truth!

I want to thank Pastor Loyd Warren and the Victory Baptist Church in advance for the incredible hospitality they will provide this October. These folks are incredible servants of God, and we are thankful for them.



perishing, Duty demands it; Strength for thy labor the Lord will provide; Back to the narrow way Patiently win them; Tell the poor wand'rer a Saviour has died...Jesus is merciful, Jesus will save. We all have a tremendous mission field within a 20-mile radius of our homes and if you cannot go

beyond that to rescue those who are perishing you can at least throw them a lifeline, by providing them with a copy of God's written Word! This ministry is in the "Lifeline" business and capable of producing a lot more "Lifelines" if given the financial resources to do so!



In an expanded July prayer/ support report letter that we mailed out a few weeks ago we included a piece by this same title, "It Take More Than..." making a request for everyone to join with us in prayer concerning a financial need that we have to raise funds for some equipment upgrades and expenses. Even though we did not ask for donations, some gracious churches and Christian friends put their prayers into action by contributing \$14,200 toward this need, "Thank You" to all of you who gave. Before I proceed any farther, please allow me to first take this opportunity to express our heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to everyone who contributes financially in anyway to this ministry, thank you! Without you, your prayers and your financial support this ministry would not be producing two million Bibles and Scriptures a year with the possibly of even exceeding that this year!

As I explained in that previous letter, since we do not use contributions designated for paper or Bible sponsors, Scripture production or shipping to pay for equipment purchases, we only have two resources to fund equipment purchases, either raise the money specifically for equipment or use undesignated love offerings. There are two problems however with undesignated love offerings, #1. There are never enough of them and #2 the number one priority for undesignated love offerings is to paper and regular operating expenses. Maybe the Lord will forgive us but we have squandered all of these funds on paper trying to grow our production. Now after eight paper price increases in the last 14 months we are spending everything we receive just to maintain our current production level! Consequently, we only have two options, either raise the funds we need for equipment through special offerings or cut back on our Scripture production, which I do not believe the Lord would have us to do!

The major part of this expense is the remaining cost to complete the installation and modifications to our larger web press, with the balance going to replace our digital printer, upgrade our computer to plate system to Windows 10 and upgrade the cut off control system on our older web press. In January, we were told that our digital printer would be good for another year or two and that the web press cut off control system could be repaired only to be informed later that the cut off controls cannot be repaired and that our digital printer has taken a turn for the worse and was now on life support. All of this on top of a paper bill for 6 trailer loads of paper! I sure am glad that we serve a mighty miracle working God, aren't you?

For almost 54 years this ministry has been a good and faithful steward of what God has provided and as a result, all of the investments that have been made in equipment and buildings are still producing fruit for the Kingdom! Most of the older used equipment that we have replaced, if it had any life left in it has been passed on to other ministries, the buildings and the property that we outgrew 6 years ago was sold with the funds reinvested in the property where we are now. Most of the Bibles and Scriptures that this ministry has produced are still out there in circulation bearing fruit somewhere.

One church contributed \$175,000 last year to purchase this second, larger web press and pay the expense to disassemble and ship it to Shelbyville. We estimate that it is going to cost another \$175,000 to pay for the reassembly and modifications to this press and another \$110,000 for the other 3 projects: to replace our digital printer, to upgrade our computer/ plate maker system and upgrade web press cutoff control on our small web press, all necessary unavoidable expenses. Any size contribution that the Lord should lay on someone's heart to give will be appreciated, or maybe, just maybe there is one individual who would like to take care of the whole \$270,000 balance or one person for each project.

With sufficient regular support and paper sponsors who knows, maybe some days those undesignated love offerings might be sufficient to cover some of these equipment expenses! To God be all the glory!

Ukraine Project Update!

Please continue to pray for the war-torn Ukrainian people, for their protection, for a victorious end to this evil war, the distribution of the New Testaments already in the country and a great Spiritual awaking as a result of these New Testaments. This ministry has printed 500,000 of our 1,000,000 goal, 212,000 of them are in the process of being distributed right now in Poland, the Ukraine and Romania with a third container of 90,000 more N.Ts on a ship that should be arriving in Poland within the next couple of weeks!


With the help of the Cornerstone Baptist Church of Crossville, TN, we are presently collating, binding, and trimming the remaining 200,000 sets of printed signatures. When completed; these N.T.'s will be divided among 3 containers going to refugees in Croatia, Romania, and Hungary.

We initially had hoped to raise a million to 1.5 million dollars to cover the expense of this project for the printing, shipping and any other expense that we might incur in the country to get these New Testaments from Poland into the Ukraine and any other expenses related to their distribution. Once we committed this ministry to this project, except for \$324,167.40 that has been contributed for paper, this ministry has borne a major part of the production expenses of this project. However, we have not been out any transportation or distribution expense in the Ukraine or Poland so far but I would at least like this ministry to be able to make a contribution of some kind

toward those expenses. A dear Ukrainian national brother by the name of Michael Ilyuk and his trucking company in the Ukraine have paid all of the transportation and customs cost in the country.

With all of the New Testaments that this ministry has shipped plus a large quantity of Ukrainian John & Romans and New Testaments provided by a couple other printing ministries. Michael and the American missionaries there have sufficient Scriptures to keep them busy for a while. For this reason, I think it is good timing that the 3 containers that we will be shipping in the next few weeks will be going to other countries where there are fewer N.T.'s available for the refugees. This will also give us some much-needed time to print a couple other language projects before returning to Ukrainian N.T.'s.

As time passes, it appears that most Americans, including most Christians, have grown weary of the Ukrainian war, becoming less sympathetic to the physical and Spiritual needs of the Ukrainian people however, given the financial resources and the personnel to do so we plan to continue working toward our "One Million" goal. At least for as long as there is a need for these Scriptures and the missionaries and Christian nationals in these countries are willing and able to distribute them. It would just be so wonderful if the financial resources were available to be able to do all of the things in this ministry that we need or would like to do! But God knows!



So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. Isaiah 55:11

When the world thinks about the greatest Wonders of the World, they look at what is magnificent, beauty beyond words, and something you have to see for yourself in order to appreciate. One of the definitions of "wonder" is a great sight, something that arrests the attention by novelty, grandeur, inexplicableness (1828). While there are many places around this earth that would be places of Wonder by way of their beauty and awe; for the Christian, wouldn't it be true that a place which produces from start to finish, the "Words of Life" (John 6:68), would be a Wonder of the Spiritual World? Such is the feeling and attitude that I had when I stepped into the Bible Barn in Shelbyville, Tennessee. To watch the press run the signatures of the Pure Words of God brings an awe and fascinating sight that is so special to see. Salvation in Print!!! To think about the hands that will open their own copy of the Word of God that was printed, collated, bound, and boxed here at the Bible Barn...what a Wonder!



Our church, a few years ago heard about the Bible and Literature Missionary Foundation through Pastor Robb Foreman and the good folks of Homeline Baptist Church in Midland, Texas. We have been missions-minded, but never thought about or considered supporting a Bible printing ministry. After seeing the presentation, the Lord showed me the need and

we took on the BLMF for support at our next missions conference. But it didn't stop there!! We then looked to start supporting the B&L through rolls of paper, along with monthly support. Then we started to plan a missions trip: to go to the Bible Barn as a church to help the Lemmon's and the workers of BLMF in anything



that they may need. Our church, Liberty Baptist Church, is located in Yuma, Arizona. It is exactly

1,885 miles to travel one-way to BLMF; yet there was excitement in planning and preparing to make the trip. Some drove, some flew, and many prayed for the trip. It was a tremendous blessing to be a part of the work of the ministry

in Shelbyville as we were able to collate and load a container of Bibles that were shipped out to a missionary in Myanmar.

What is your Wonder of the World? Do the things and places of this world mean more to you than the spiritual? I'd rather spend time in this ministry of putting Scripture together than to go on a lavish cruise to see great places of the earth! What brings more glory to God? What brings eternal riches? Perhaps the Lord is putting this ministry on the heart of a pastor for support? Perhaps the Lord is giving an opportunity for a church closer to Tennessee than we are to dedicate time for a "missions trip".
