

In 2023 we were given the opportunity to buy a ten acre commercial lodge in Botswana at a cost of \$435,000. It will be used for a Bible college, Christian camp, Pastor's training center, and a host of other things. One of the miraculous ways that God provided those funds (in less than five months time) was through BLMF.

We had \$20,000 set aside in our ministry savings anticipating the need for another container of English New Testaments. We also had less than five months to raise the \$435k required to purchase the property so every dollar was precious. When Brother Lemmon contacted us to tell us that he could provide a container full of NT's to us that was already completely paid for, it enabled us to put that \$20,000 toward the purchase of the property. We're so thankful and give glory to God for the way He has multiplied the benefit of those who have given and worked to make this possible.

Every year, our ministry hosts six Soul Winning & Leadership Conferences, two in each of the three major regions of our country. 

A man in our church had gotten a burden for his cousin who lived in a village 4 hours east of Entebbe. We got a free day and drove to the village in search of a man named Peter.


Upon reaching the village the first person we saw was a relative who directed us to Peter's house; he wasn't there but the relative knew where he could find him, at the local drinking spot. They retrieved him, brought him to the house where we were waiting on him, and we were taken back by this man's appearance. We sat down with him, shared the Gospel, warned him of sin and its penalty and told him of Jesus and his payment; after 20-30 minutes we were finished and we left him with a Bible. Six months passed and we received a call; it was Peter. He had accepted Christ and had been born again. We traveled there, baptized him, and began discipling him. Today, Namiganda Baptist Church is hosted in the house of Peter, and they have begun construction on their church building. Peter is now distributing Bibles to his neighbors, and many in the Village of Namiganda have come to Christ. This is the testimony of one Bible placed in the hand and planted in the Heart. The fact that the average life expectancy in Sierra Leone is only 44 years of age, it truly is amazing to see how God waited patiently for Mr. Williams to finally hear the Gospel and receive his very own Bible.



I am so thankful for the opportunity to serve with International Baptist Outreach Missions located in Asheville, N.C. as a Field Missionary representing Kenya, Uganda Africa. IBOM has to date 236 church plants and 114 completed church buildings in Africa.

This Year the Lord has enabled IBOM to start 9 new church plants and build 14 Church buildings with national pastors in Africa. This year at a glance a total of 567 were saved and 2,634 Bibles were distributed to those present during the 14 church building dedications. Also, this year at a glance IBOM Africa Church plants distributed a total of 23,000 KJV Bibles with hundreds accepting the Lord Jesus Christ as Saviour. We have a combined total with over 20,000 attending the IBOM church plants.

The past and present success of IBOM ministry is primarily contributed to BLMF printing and providing Bibles to the IBOM Africa ministry. They are worthy of our prayers and financial support.

As I contemplate the impact that BLMF has had on our ministry, I am overwhelmed! It humbles me to think about all those who sacrificially give, so that we can give free Bibles to those who've never held a Bible in their hands. There are not enough words to express our gratitude for the ministry of BLMF and to all those faithful supporters that make it possible for us to give out free Bibles in Croatia.

We have personally received three containers from BLMF with one more on the way. As we give out Bibles on the streets of Croatia, people constantly tell me that this is the first Bible they've ever owned. Many times, we are asked, "How it is possible for you to give out these Bibles for free?" What an opportunity to share the Gospel! We tell them though these Bibles are free to you someone had to pay for them. We explain about the many Christians in the USA who sacrifice so that the Croatian people can have the Word of God. Then we have the privilege of telling them that salvation is just like these Bibles. It is a gift of God, because the Lord Jesus has already paid for it in full!

Because of BLMF and their many supporters, we are giving out free Bibles in the city of Split during the month of December. Already we've given out 250 Bibles and are on pace to pass out a 1,000 Bibles by the end of the month. All this effort affects our work in a huge way; the people of Croatia are impacted with the Word of God, our people have their faith and boldness for the Lord increased, and our Church grows spiritually and numerically. I don't know of another ministry in the world making the difference that BLMF is making for the Kingdom of God.

Shipped April 26 50,000 Scriptures

The Scriptures still have power today. We have seen God use the Scriptures sent to us through BLMF to open doors with the police and military in Honduras. Honduran police frequently visit our ministries to pick up boxes of New Testaments that they gladly distribute to the general public. They pass them out in different forms. In many cases, they pass them out at police checkpoints where they stop vehicles to inspect their papers. And in exchange every occupant in the vehicle will get a New Testament. At police sponsored youth events every attendee receives a free New Testament.

The result of this mass distribution by both church members and police has been that the Word of God has spread nationwide. A national newspaper was reporting on a traffic accident that occurred in a different region of the country. Included with the story was the picture of the driver who was recovering from his injuries. On the bed next to him was a BLMF New Testament that he had received. According to the picture, this Bible had been well read.

During our visit to a remote village in Bidar, we encountered an elderly woman. Whose desire for the Word of God greatly moved our hearts. Although she couldn't read due to her age and lack of education, she approached us asking for a Bible. It opened doors to opportunities she had never imagined, and her life became a living testimony to the promise in Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."



With finances from a fund that has been set up by our sending church, we helped him pay for the bus transportation.








Shipped February 8 74,000 Scriptures



In Philippines, hundreds of thousands of bilingual Tagalog-English New Testaments are distributed in evangelistic and discipleship campaigns in schools, on campuses, institutions, government bases, police, jail, universities, and many more open doors. Churches across the islands are laboring to turn their nation back to God, and they understand the generations to come must be readied now! BLMF has provided not only a bilingual edition New Testament, but an English specially-marked edition with 20 discipleship lessons included. These lessons are used by teachers and students, staff and faculty, as well as police officers, military and even those in rehab programs and jails, and discipleship programs in local churches. Many refer to this as value classes, teaching morals, ethics, integrity, honesty, purity, and a spiritual relationship with God that promotes a national respect. What was once common here, is becoming common there as doors open to evangelism and Christ-centered education with their textbook, the Bible.

As a church, we had been blessed to partner with our provincial Police personel. They assist us in giving Bibles to public schools and government offices. When we give away Bibles, we are given enough time to preach the Gospel. In each Bible are also Gospel tracts inserted.

It is a customary practice here for our municipal/town/city officials to give a Christmas Gift/Package to every family in their town every Christmas. The Christmas package would normally be groceries and other food items. With this, I have asked two mayors in our province if they can put a Bible in each package and they not gladly accepted it with gratefulness. Each family in the town of Luna, Apayao and Sta. Marcela will receive a Bible this Christmas. We gave 6,144 Bibles and 1,300 NT to Luna, Apayao and 4,160 Bibles for Sta. Marcela, Apayao.

The major focus over the last 12-18 months has been shipments into Poland, Ukraine, and Romania. These efforts have produced an amazing amount of return on our investments. Our prayers have been answered! Souls have been saved! Christians have been revived, churches are being strengthened, and lives changed. For me, maybe the most exciting part is the seeds planted. The hope and expectation of the Harvest that is yet to come thrills my soul. With the promise that God's Word will never return void, or a single syllable ever falling to the ground, let us say with William Borden, "No reserves. No retreats. No regrets."

Earlier this year, we received word from a small village town in Zhytomyr, Ukraine. Missionaries Tony and Coretta's church planting effort had experienced some wonderful growth which they said can be traced back to the two containers they received. In their words, "Many people had come to our services because they had received aid.... Some stayed and some did not. But the good news is that 4 out of the 5 families saved and baptized this year are in direct connection to the two containers they received."

So, may we never fail to find comfort and to share comfort with the words of the Apostle Paul when he said that, "Your labor is not in vain in the Lord." I Cor. 15:58b
