

### 20 Languages Containers Pountries


This is our production and distribution goal for 2020 - what we are calling "A 20/20 Vision for 2020!" Instead of starting in January and going through December of 2020, this project began at last year's October Scripture conference and will go through this year's Scripture Conference, October 19 through 21. Since last year's Scripture Conference, we have already shipped 5 of these languages in 5 containers going to 5 different countries: Burmese Bibles for Myanmar, Kannada Bibles for India, Tagalog bilingual N.Ts, for the Philippines, English Bibles for Kenya, and Spanish Bibles for Honduras. Of the 500,000 Bibles and Scriptures that we have printed since January 1st, we have 3 more languages: Portuguese Bibles, Croatian Bibles and French/ English bilingual New Testaments ready or almost ready to ship going to 3 different countries. A ninth language, the Wayana Bible, is on the press, and we are working on a container of Korean Bible portions accounting for 10 of the 20 languages, 10 more to go!

esides these, we just shipped a Dsecond container to Africa and have 3 more containers: one each of English, Spanish and Tagalog Bibles and Scriptures ready to ship. While they count in our total production, they do not count toward our "20/20" goal because they are duplicates of languages we have already shipped. We anticipate having 9 or 10 of these duplicate languages this year resulting in a possible 29 to 30 containers of Scriptures if given sufficient funds to purchase the paper and materials!

your prayers and **V** faithful financial support, contributions and love offerings, we purchased 21 trailer loads of paper in 2019 from these we were able to ship 20 containers, a total of 1./4 million Bibles and Scriptures in 7 languages to 15 different countries. This total does not include smaller quantities of pallets and cases in other languages going to several other countries. Obviously, 21 trailer loads of paper are not going to be sufficient to produce 29 or 30 containers of Bibles and Scriptures this year when it took 21 trailer loads of paper to produced 20 containers of Scriptures last year. We have received 10 trailer loads of paper this year, and paid for 8 of them. We will need 30 trailer loads of paper this year in order to produce enough Bibles and Scriptures to produce the 20/20 containers plus the other 9 or 10 containers of duplicate languages.

ne thing is for sure: we had not planned on being down 3 and a half weeks on account of the Chinese Coronavirus! We have the

capacity to make up the time we have lost, so it ultimately all comes down to the cost of the paper and materials. When the trumpet sounds and the rapture occurs, we want to have these Scriptures plus tons more on the mission field. In light of the Spiritual, economic, and political condition of our country, we may not have much longer to work! Jesus said, "Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come," Mt. 24:42... vs 44, "Therefore be ye also ready:...!" Lift up your heads and look up for our redemption draweth nigh! Even so, come Lord Jesus!

Speaking of looking, the Bible speaks of another place where we need to be looking! Jesus says in John 4:35, "...behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest."

When Jesus was in Galilee He "saw' the multitude and was moved with compassion and in Mt. 9:36 and Lk. 19:41 when Jesus came near Jerusalem, He beheld the city and wept over it. May God help us to see the lost people of this world through His eyes!



A very special "Thank You" to all of you who partner with this ministry to make it possible and productive! Thank you for your prayers, for every contribution, every trailer load of paper, roll of paper and every Bible you have sponsored and for every special love offering given. God bless you all!

A total of \$371,444.17 has been received since January 1st for Scripture production and distribution. With these funds this ministry has printed over 700,000 Bibles and Scriptures this year, shipped 312,800 of them in 4 containers with the contents left here in the shop to fill 4 more containers, either already finished or in the process of being finished! These containers are: Portuguese and Wayana Bibles for Suriname, S.A., Spanish Bibles and New Testaments for Honduras, French/English New Testaments for Haiti, and Croatian Bibles.


To produce these Scriptures, we have purchased 8 trailer loads of paper this year, 349 rolls of paper at a cost of \$272,653.68, spent \$41,887.67 for vinyl cover stock and \$31,456.76 paper, cover stock, ink, plates, glues and miscellaneous printing supplies, not counting equipment repairs, shipping and utilities.

Most of all, we cannot thank and praise the Lord enough for His blessings upon this ministry this year and for all of the previous 51 years; God has been good, so good! We started the year purchasing two trailer loads of paper a month then dropped back to one a month in April and May during our three and a half week shut down. I'm sure our Governor would have exempted us from his stay at home mandate and would have considered this ministry as essential

but for the safety of our workers we did not challenge his order. For me personally, at the very same time I had a second mandate from my heart surgeon telling me not to do anything or go anywhere for at least three weeks!

Since our web press is capable of printing three trailer loads of paper a month, given sufficient paper we can make up for the lost production. However, in order to reach our 29 container goal for our "20/20 Vision for 2020" we need to be purchasing 2.5 trailer loads of paper a month. Fundraising is the part of this ministry that we do not have any control over; it's just whatever the Lord provides! We can share the need, and we can go around to churches with our hand out asking for help but unless the Lord puts it in the hearts of His people to help all else is vain. We can plant and water but only He can produce the increase. We know that prayer moves the heart and mind of Christ, so just keep praying.

I will give you one verse of Scripture that should be sufficient to motivate us all to do all that we can to get God's precious Word to as many as we can as soon as we can! Heb. 4:12, "For the Word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." God has given us all what we need to reach the world with the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ: His Word, the Holy Spirit, and He has collectively blessed his people with the financial means to accomplish it. Jesus is coming soon. Have you been paying attention to what is going on in the news recently?



In his epistles, the apostle Paul frequently speaks of the battles, hardships and sufferings that he has faced as a servant of Jesus Christ and warns us as Christians that in this life all who walk godly will face persecution and afflictions. Consequently, in his instructions to Timothy in II Tim. 2:3 he says, "Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ." Then in Ephesians chapter 6, after his instructions to children, fathers, servants and masters in verses 1-9, the apostle Paul gives us an exhortation in verse 10 to "...be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might." In verse, 11 & 12 we are instructed to "Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." The apostle clearly specifies that our battle is not against flesh and blood but against the wiles of the devil. Wiles meaning devious, cunning, stratagems employed in manipulating or persuading others to do what he wants!

In this life, in spite of how kind, humble, patient, and understanding we may try to be we will occasionally find someone who may not like us, maybe even an enemy or two along the way but none like our "...adversary the devil," who as a roaring lion is seeking to devour us, I Pet 5:8. In this verse, the apostle warns us to be sober and vigilant for the devil, our adversary, is tracking us like a lion does his prey! He is continually looking for an opportunity to rob Christians of their joy, peace and by temptation and deception if possible, your testimony and if we let him, cause us to become a stumbling block to others and to the cause of Christ! He became our adversary the minute we trusted Christ, and he is not going away until he has made us a nonfactor and ineffective! As Jesus told Peter, Satan has desired to have you that he may sift you as wheat! Satan is a relentless, evil, persistent adversary!

Know your enemy! In any kind of warfare, the first and most important thing that an opposing general or commander can do is to learn all they can about their enemy. They want to know who the enemy is, their strengths and weaknesses, the kinds and number of their armaments, number of soldiers, their tendencies, everything they can possibly learn about them to properly prepare and hopefully gain an advantage. How appropriate that the apostle would tell us to endure hardness as a good soldier because we are literally in a spiritual warfare with the devil. He is sly, wicked, deceitful and will stop at nothing to get what he wants, ever busy building his kingdom and in the process he must destroy everything that is Godly, identified with Christ and all Christians who are living for the Lord!

God's Word reveals all that we need to know about the devil, but unfortunately, many Christians are ignorant of our adversary the devil because they are ignorant of God's Word. His name "Satan" means "adversary". In Eze. 28:2 God calls him "the prince of Tyrus" and tells us he was the anointed cherub before his fall. How he was lifted up in pride because of his beauty, perfect in every way since the day that he was created, until iniquity was found in him. In Isa. 14:12 he is called "Lucifer" meaning "brightness", son of the morning. We have the account of his pride and subsequent fall, among his many other names he is called the "serpent" in Genesis chapter 3. In the New Testament, the "prince and power of the air" but most often he is called the devil meaning "slanderer, or accuser". In addition, Beelzebub, Belial, the Dragon, wicked one, deceiver, the god of this world, the son of perdition are a few of the other names he is called by. If you think you can leave him alone and he'll leave you alone, you are ignorant of his devices!

In II Cor. 2:11 the apostle Paul exhorts us to not be ignorant of his devices "Lest Satan should get an advantage of us:...!" Read the "Book", for that is where we will find the armor and receive the power of God that we all need to combat and defeat this wicked adversary the devil! Satan acknowledges in Isa. 14:13 & 14 what his intentions are, "...I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High." True, he was defeated at the cross, Heb. 2:14, but that has only made him all the more determined. If you think he has given up, you are ignorant of his devices, read the Book! To accomplish his objective he is working overtime helped by a growing number of willing accomplices, one-third of the angels, a vast number of academia who are too smart to believe in a creator God, and a very large number of liberal politicians and media who relish the power he gives them. Who but Satan, using a God-hating communistic nation like China, could come up with such an evil and sinister plan to destroy our freedom and our American way of life as he is attempting to do right now? If you think Satan is just sitting around waiting on God to throw him in the bottomless pit, just watch the news or better yet, read the "Book", and check out Revelations chapter 12! Satan has to bring America into a one world socialistic form of government in order to make the world ready for his coming kingdom. The unsaved are easy subjects and unfortunately, so are many Christians because so many are ignorant of God's Word. Obviously, to accomplish his objective he must destroy everything in this country that is good, decent, righteous and Godly! If you are a devil hating, God fearing, Christ honoring child of God, Satan hates you because you are an obstacle, an obstruction in his way to his goal.

Never underestimate your enemy! In this spiritual warfare that we are engaged in we must be "sober and vigilant" and never underestimate our enemy, Satan and his power. In Dan. 10:12 & 13, an angel was sent to Daniel to reveal the interpretation of Daniel's vision, but Satan, here called "the prince of the kingdom of Persia", delayed the angel 20 days until Michael the archangel came and rescued him. Jude 1:9 says the devil contended with Michael the archangel over the body of Moses. II Cor. 11:14, ".... for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light." Vs. 15, "Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness;..." Satan is the root of all of the evil in this world, he is the "prince and power of the air" meaning that he controls this worlds system. In Genesis, 3:1, Satan Enemy continued on Page 4

Acts 26:18 and II Cor. 4:4 say that he blinds the eyes of the lost from the light of the gospel. In Luke 8:12, when the Word is sown then cometh the devil "... and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved." In Mat. 13:19, he is the enemy who sows the tares among the wheat, a picture of false believers among the saved. For the sheer pleasure of it, at his will Satan can possess the body

This earth and everything in it belongs to God who created it; Satan just thinks he owns it and for now, God is willing to let him think so. All the while, God is using Satan for His purpose! If this were not the case, God would have destroyed him the instant that iniquity was found in him! Satan, the exalted cherub, the most beautiful, most talented, gifted, and the most powerful of God's creation, living in a perfect sinless environment was consumed with pride and rebelled

The Scriptures tell us that man is created a little lower than the angels and inferior to them, but like Satan and the angels, man was created with a free will, able to make our own choices and man through Adam made the wrong choice as did Satan! God did not put that iniquity in Satan's heart; the choice was his. Neither can Satan make us sin, but like Eve in the Garden of Eden, through temptation and deceit, Satan can make us want to! God did not make all humans sinners because of Adam's sin; Adam's sin just revealed the sin nature of all humans. The next six thousand years has only proved that we are all sinners! But, thanks be to God, he has given mankind the opportunity to make another choice, a choice that will eradicate all of our sin. By choosing Jesus, we are made clean, washed in Jesus' sinless blood and restored to a position like that of Adam before the fall, just as though we had never sinned! Jesus did not die for the angels therefore there isn't any redemption for Satan and the angels who chose to follow him but we have a choice!

Satan is not omnipotent or omnipresent but he has supernatural power. II Th. 2:9 says "... the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders" he is evil personified! Jesus told the Scribes and the Pharisees, the religious leaders in John 8:44, "Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it." I Jh. 3:8, "He that committeth sin is of the devil..." Satan is the root of everything that is • wicked, evil and corrupt in this world but God keeps him around to give man a choice, we can choose Jesus or Satan, heaven or hell, life or death! Jesus delayed His coming Kingdom • for a stop at the cross to pay for the sins of all mankind giving whosoever will an invitation to become sons of God and part of His kingdom. It's our choice, what will it be for you, God or Satan?

There are two powers in this world • and we are going to have to choose one • or the other because this world and earth as we know them are coming to an end. Satan's demise is described in

Rev. 20:1-3, 10, and those who follow him and reject Christ can see what is in store for them in verses 11-15. All who chose Jesus and His gift of eternal life will have a new heaven and the new earth as seen in Rev. 21 & 22! "And so shall we ever be with the Lord.", I Thes. 4:17b. I John 3:10 tells us that we are either the "children of God" or the "children of the devil"! I Cor. 2:12, "Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God;...." I Jh. 4:5&6, "They are "of

the world" or "of God", the "spirit of truth" or the "spirit of error." Joshua told the children of

Israel to "...choose you this day whom ye will serve;....but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Josuah

As Satan did to Job, he has continued doing to the saints of God all down through the ages. He caused the fall of man and put it in the heart of Cain to kill Able. He influenced the "sons of God" to take wives of the daughters of Seth in an attempt to corrupt and destroy the bloodline and lineage of Christ which resulted with the flood! He was the instigator behind the tower of Babel. He planted the resentment in the hearts of Joseph's brothers to kill him, he was responsible for Pharaoh's wife falsely accusing Joseph, and he caused another Pharaoh to kill all of the Israelite sons under two.
