Are your students struggling to attend, achieve or engage positively inside the mainstream curriculum?

Do you have any students who:

- Have chronically low attendance
- Are at risk of permanent exclusion
- Demonstrate disruptive behaviours
- Have additional SEND or SEMH needs that are difficult to meet
- Struggle to learn in an academic environment
- Suffer from trauma or attachment disorder behaviours that are impacting their ability to learn
- Struggle with social anxiety
- Need high-ratio extra care and support due to difficult home lives
- Display behaviours that make them particularly vulnerable to exploitation and safeguarding risks
- Have exceptionally low self-esteem and confidence preventing them from thriving

OUR SOLUTION: Blended attendance programme

We work in collaboration with our partner schools to provide a blended attendance programme that aims to boost students' engagement in a range of opportunities, whilst gaining valuable transferable life skills.

We achieve this through providing practical, youth-led projects that are driven by their own interests and passions; helping them to learn without realising it! The young people that engage with us are encouraged to improve skills such as teamwork, communication and emotional resilience.

They are continually supported with their academic development through real-life experience and structured business projects, which enable students to experience different vocational skill areas. This often leads to the identification of a career interest, improved self-esteem, and hope for their future.

1:1 Therapeutic SEMH Mentoring
