VACANCY FOR CO-OPTED COUNCILLOR

Are you interested in local current affairs? Do you wish to serve your community? Could you provide a voice for residents?

Laughton Parish Council is seeking to co-opt a new Councillor. The person coopted to the Council will be required to sign a declaration that they will conform to the requirements of the Code of Conduct for Local Councillors.

The Parish Council meets monthly, generally the third Wednesday of the month.

To qualify as a Co-opted Councillor, a person must be either:

• A British citizen or an eligible Commonwealth citizen

And:

- 18 years or over
- Not disqualified by any statute

And:

- Be an elector of the Parish or
- Has resided in the parish for the past twelve months or rented/tenanted land or other premises in the parish, or
- Has their principle place of work in the parish, or
- Lives within three miles of the parish boundary

Applicants are asked to complete an application form, which is available by contacting the Clerk as above.

Applications should be received by Wednesday 10th April 2024. If successful, the applicant will be co-opted onto the Council at the meeting on Wednesday 17th April 2024.
