

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2023 NEW ENGLAND FRATERNAL ALLIANCE



GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

Award: Two \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded by the New England Fraternal Alliance to students in their sophomore, junior, or senior year in college or in graduate school. The first is named in memory of Pearl Plante, a loyal and tireless worker for the New England Fraternal Alliance; the second is named in memory of Normand Ouellette, a Past President and heart of the Alliance.

Eligibility: Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college/university or graduate school.

Applicant must be a resident of New England and a member of a fraternal benefit society that holds a membership in the New England Fraternal Alliance or the son or daughter of a member of a fraternal benefit society that holds a membership in the New England Fraternal Alliance.

Applicant must have a cumulative grade average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 system). Transcript of grades from spring 2023 semester must be submitted with application.

Application for scholarship award must be completed in its entirety and submitted by September 1, 2023. Incomplete and/or late entries will be disqualified.

Procedures: The \$1,000.00 scholarship awards will be paid directly to Recipients.

The deadline for submission of applications for the Scholarship awards will be September 1, 2023. There will be absolutely no extension of the deadline.

Criteria to be used in judging: overall merits of applicant, Cumulative grade average, college activities/honors, community activities, financial need and essay content.

From among the entries, top ten applications will be selected and referred to a three-member panel for final judging.

Recipients of NEFA scholarship awards will be notified by October 15, 2023.
