

What is it?

A free 7-month programme of specialist workshops, advice and coaching supporting people from a refugee background living in the UK to get their social business up and running.

Is it for me?

If you are, or have been, a refugee in the UK, are confident at learning in English and have a great idea for a social business which could benefit the community – yes!

How will it work?

You will work and learn in a group with 9 other social entrepreneurs, mainly online and with 3 events face-to-face. Workshops and professional coaching will help you develop your personal confidence, business, marketing and fundraising skills. The programme will run from Nov 22 to June 23. It is part-time, but you must be able to commit to the programme and to putting in the work to make your social business happen. The programme is run in English, so you need to be confident enough in the language to benefit from it.

Who is running this?

With generous National Lottery Community Fund support, three specialist social enterprises – <u>Result CIC</u>, <u>TERN</u> (The Entrepreneurial Refugee Network) and <u>Social Enterprise UK</u> – will provide your programme.
