1. RECEPTION AND SHOP (Grade II*)
Originally used as a laboratory for the mill.

2. BOILER HOUSE (Grade II*)
Built in 1904 complete with new Cornish boiler.

3. BEAM WINDING ENGINE HOUSE (Grade II*)
Erected 1868. Replaced by a new horizontal twin drum steam winding engine.

4. VIEW POINT

This view, along the Great Flat Lode, is one of the great mining landscapes in Britain.

5. ENGINE SHAFT

400 feet (125 m.) deep, was started in 1864. Abandoned in 1921 when the mine flooded.

6. HOLMAN WINDER

This winding engine was erected here in 1908 and currently runs on compressed air.

7. MILL ENGINE ROOM (Grade II*)

Now the Museum to explain mining history.

8. STAMPS HOUSE (Grade II*)

Erected in 1901 to house the Californian Stamps from the Paris Exposition of 1900.

9. CORNISH MILL (Grade II*)

Erected 1902-1904 to house the working mill which is demonstrated during the guided tour.

10. CALCINER (Grade II*)

Here the tin concentrate was roasted to remove heavy minerals iron, copper & arsenic.

11. TOILETS

For museum visitors.



12. CROUST HUT CAFÉ (Grade II*)

Original Sampling Shed/Weigh Bridge built in 1870 and completely restored in 2017. Open for light snacks and meals.

13. SURVEY OFFICE (Grade II*)

Built in 1897 for students to learn surveying. CSM and Survey exhibition (not included in the tour).

14 NEW BLACKSMITH'S SHOP

Furnace and anvil. Was Rock Drill Shop. (not included in the tour).

15. SOUTH CONDURROW STAMPS

ENGINE HOUSE (Grade II*) Erected in 1869, operated a battery of Cornish

16. COUNT HOUSE (Grade II*)
Original mine office built in 1865. Now rural workshop.

17. ORIGINAL BLACKSMITH'S SHOP (Grade II*)
Original mine building built in 1870. Now rural workshop.

18. MINERS' DRY AND CARPENTERS' SHOP (Grade II*)
Change House built around 1870. Now rural workshop.

19. VANNING, ASSAY AND DARK ROOMS (Grade II*)
Original mine workshops built in 1904. Now rural workshop.
