The Dinner Party: Multicultural Crossroads in Clay

A juried exhibit of Utilitarian and Sculptural Art Potters' Guild of Las Cruces At the Branigan Cultural Center in Las Cruces November 1, 2024, to January 18, 2025

CALL FOR SUBMISSION

ELIGIBILITY: You must be a current member of the Potters' Guild of Las Cruces. (www.pottersguildlc.org)

This show encourages artists to use crosses or crossroad motifs (realistic or abstract) to display cultural identification with the 175th Celebration of Las Cruces and Mesilla. Historically, crosses marked burials or were directional crossroads. This Dinner Party Show is in honor of you as clay artists and as Potters' Guild members.

SUBMISSIONS CRITERIA: One submission per artist of a Dinner Place Setting. One submission consists of three CERAMIC FIRED pieces that are balanced and go together as a set. You will be notified if your submission is accepted or not accepted into the show.

- 1) a dinner plate 10" in diameter or square or rectangle shape but not to exceed more than 11" in one direction and the sq inches of 10" round
- 2) a drinking vessel with or without a handle(s)
- 3) a salad plate or small bowl (maximum diameter is 8")
- 4) The height of any piece cannot exceed 20" or be unstable. Ornaments or multimedia other than clay may be added but cannot be more than 10% of the piece.

Submission **must** include a word document with:

- 1. One-page maximum write up biography and purpose about your submitted piece. Topics can include your work in ceramics, history of Las Cruces or Mesilla, meaning behind piece, art/ceramic business, experiences, or the clay.
- 2. A minimum of one and a maximum of three photos of your piece that may be used for promotion/advertising.
- 3. Information about piece including:
 - A. Title of Piece
 - b. Your name/how you would like your name presented on the label.
 - c. Medium/Material used in the piece.
 - d. Exact dimensions of three pieces L x W x H
 - e. Any special handling considerations.
 - f. Insurance value of piece.

The Branigan Cultural Center (BCC) will not promote sales, so if your piece is for sale, you may include that information in your bio. BCC will design postcards, promote, install, maintain, and host the show.

REMEMBER...Crossroads/Crosses must be represented in your entry.

The submission fee is \$30. This fee is for awards. Awards are, but not limited to:

- 1) Best utilitarian
- 2) Best sculpture
- 3) Best historical
- 4) Best use of materials
- 5) The John Rawlings Award
- 6) Possible additional awards, dependent on juror's decision.

Juror, John Rawlings, is a Professor Emeritus of Art and Art History. He is a sculptor of many media but currently focuses on sawdust fired ceramic forms. He incorporates found and natural objects in his work seeking contrast with the rich black of his ceramic forms. His work is represented in collections around the world.
