Mark 14:12-16 ~ March 24, 2024

Main idea: God is always at work - often behind the scenes - to carry out His purpose.

The Passover

The blood of the Passover lamb marked God's people for deliverance.

The Provision

God always provides according to His purpose.

The Preparation

While the disciples prepared the Passover meal, God continued to prepare the true Passover.

The gospel of Jesus according to Mark is the good news that the Son of God and Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for all who will turn to Him in faith and enter the kingdom of God.
