This 5/10k walk, rated 1B, is almost completely flat and includes paved paths, unpaved natural trails in the Garden. Some paths may be difficult when wet. The Norfolk Botanical Garden includes over 150 acres of beautiful natural and classical landscapes offering changing vistas throughout the year. The Dismal Swamp Canal is located along the eastern edge of the Great Dismal Swamp. It is the oldest continuously operating man-made canal in the US, having opened in 1805. -Friday-Sunday, Dec 10-12: Williamsburg Holiday Walks/Swim- Events- 2 walks & 1 swim, sponsored by the Pathfinders. The annual holiday tradition is back and it's an <u>extra special</u> weekend this year because Colonial Williamsburg is offering their "Grand Illumination" programming this weekend! This means that on Dec 10-11, in addition to having our wonderful day walk and night walk along with all the creative door wreaths and decorations, you will also

get to experience some EXTRA TREATS! This is what is currently scheduled, subject to change by Colonial Williamsburg:

--On **Friday**, **Dec 10**, **6pm**, there will be a community <u>Yule Log procession</u> along Duke of Gloucester Street, with <u>cressets lining the street</u> and a <u>bonfire near the Magazine</u>, as well as <u>18th-century entertainment until 8pm</u>.

-On **Saturday, Dec 11, starting at 5pm**, CW will offer a <u>holiday play</u>, <u>18th-century music</u> and other Yuletide favorites, and an <u>appearance by Father Christmas</u>, culminating in <u>18th-century</u>inspired fireworks at the Governor's Palace and Capitol building (the "**Grand Illumination**").

<u>Start point</u> for walks and swim is the <u>Best Western-Williamsburg Historic</u> hotel, 351 York Street, Williamsburg, VA. The start/finish will be in the Settler's Room, upstairs and to the left, the room we have been in for past years (except 2020). Masks <u>may</u> be required in the public

spaces in the hotel or in the start/finish room, so please bring a mask, just in case. The hotel is offering a special room rate of \$72 plus tax, per night, for a single/double/triple/quad room. **Call the hotel by** <u>November 7</u> at 757-229-4100 and tell them you are part of the Peninsula Pathfinders' group to ensure you can get this reduced rate. After November 7, there is no guarantee that you will be able to get the special rate. It will depend on the level of occupancy of the hotel. If front desk doesn't know about the special rate, please ask to speak to the manager, Debby. The hotel has some new staff at the front desk. The hotel is offering a "grab and go" breakfast option from 7-10 (bottled water, juice, granola bar, fruit, and choice of muffin or yogurt & cereal.; coffee in lobby.) The restaurant on site,



Taqueria Maria Bonita Bar & Grill is open for lunch and dinner (eat in or take-out).

Night Walk: Friday, Dec 10 and Saturday, Dec 11. Start 3:00-6:00pm. Finish by 9:00pm. The night 5/6 or 10/11k walk trails are primarily in Colonial Williamsburg. Walkers are encouraged to bring a flashlight. The night award is the 4"x4" patch pictured here. *Often the awards sell out prior to the walk*. Preregistration is \$8.50 for the night award and IVV credit. <u>Registration mailed after Dec 1 and at the event, is \$9 for the night award and credit</u>.

Day Walk: Saturday, Dec 11 and Sunday, Dec 12. Start 8:00am-1:00pm. Finish by 4:00pm. The day 5k walk trail is primarily in Colonial Williamsburg. The day 10k walk trail will be through Colonial Williamsburg, the city of Williamsburg, and a small bit in the College of William & Mary. Preregistration for the day award, a wooden block cutout of the Alexander Purdie House, and



IVV credit, costs \$17.50 until Dec 1. Often the awards sell out prior to the walk. Registration mailed after Dec 1 and at the event, is \$18.00 for the day award and credit.

<u>Swim: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, Dec 10, 11, 12</u>. Start 3:00-6:00pm on Friday; 10:00am-6:00pm on Saturday; and 10:00am-1:00pm on Sunday Swim must be finished by 9:00pm on Friday and Saturday and by 4:00pm on Sunday. The credit only fee for the swim is \$3.00.



A hall may only be used once, even if multiple walks go by it. The patch (image coming soon) depicts the Ashland town hall and the Fredericksburg city hall, both in Virginia.
