The Beginning

Chapter 1

Adam and Eve

Christ said he is the beginning and the end. And the reason he said this is because he was present at the beginning of time and he will be there at the end. So, to begin, we will look at the beginning and how creation came about.

When you read Genesis, at first, it seems like Adam and Eve were the only two people God created, and that is usually how the story goes. Yet, upon additional study of the Bible, you'll find other people existed too. And the first question people have is, "Where did these people come from?"

Many speculate as to why there were other human beings. However, when you search Scripture, you will find the reason is explained in Genesis five, verse two. This tells us when God created human beings: male and female created them. and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created Genesis 5:2. In other words, what that explains is, the first men and women established were named Adam. The name Adam in Hebrew translated means human being.

Additionally, Scripture explains when God created humankind, He said to those in heaven, "Let's make man in our image". This is written in Genesis one, verse twenty-six. To whom was the Lord-God speaking? As this book continues it will reveal the angels in heaven resemble humankind. Thereby, the angels are the men of heaven, as even Revelation five, verse three also suggests. Thereby, when humans were created the Lord said unto the angels "Let's make man in our image" and it came to be so.

Scripture tells us the man the Lord God created was formed out of the dust of the ground, and He breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and the man became a living soul Genesis 2:7. After which the Lord planted a garden eastward in Eden there, He put the man whom He had formed, Genesis 2:8.

The Lord-God has always had those He elected, like Abraham, Moses, or Lot. And the Lord chose the man whom He created and placed him in the Garden of Eden. His name was Adam and the Lord told him: "Of every tree of the garden thou may eat. But of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, you shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eats thereof you shall surely die" Genesis 2:15-17.

Adam's job in the Garden of Eden was to dress and keep the Garden as Genesis two: fifteen explains.

And the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make a helpmate for him", Genesis 2:18. And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man, Genesis 2:21-22. Hence the Lord created one man Adam and out of his rib Eve was formed.

Those found outside of the Garden of Eden were created by those in heaven. This being the case it was still by God's power in the men of heaven that made this possible. Not much else is given about their formation other than those in heaven were asked to help with their creation. And it is also recorded once created it was their job to, "have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth" Genesis 2:26.

After many days while Adam and Eve were residing in the Garden of Eden, a serpent approached Eve and convinced her she would not surely die if she ate from the forbidden tree; recorded in Genesis three verse four. Did a snake talk? At this point, I can't ascertain how the serpent conveyed his message. But what I do know, as an example, my dog lets me know when she wants to go outside, when she wants to go to bed, and if she wants a treat.

They lived in paradise so the question I had, was why would the Lord God tempt Adam and Eve by putting a forbidden tree in their mist? However, searching Scripture I found the reason! As Jeremiah seventeen verse nine explains the heart is deceitful and WHO can know it? And "I the Lord search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings" Jeremiah 17:9. Even Psalm's in a prayer to the Lord says:




"Search me, O God, and know my heart: Try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting, Psalm 139: 23,24. And what this is basically telling us is God gave us two eyes to see, ears to hear, a mouth to talk, and a mind to think. But what motivates an individual given a free will could not be determined. Thereby, when the Lord God created humankind, everyone's motives had to be tested. Having to try humanity was the apparent reason the forbidden tree of knowledge was even in the Garden of Eden. And the entire reason for this will be explained as this book continues.

So regardless of how the serpent communicated his message, what is essential to understand is Eve didn't believe what the Lord instructed; rather, she decided to accept the lies the snake shared. Hence, she ate the fruit and she also convinced Adam to eat some.



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The next thing I realized is God does not use our standard of time. Scripture explains a thousand years, to God, is like one day. And the reason this is important to understand is because Scripture explains: all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died. If God is true and he told Adam he would die the same day he ate the fruit. Therefore, Adam died before he was a thousand years old, which was in God's time. All written in Second Peter three: eight, Genesis five: five, Genesis three: twenty-two.

Now before Adam and Eve passed away, they had two sons named Cain and the other Able. We don't know how all of the circumstances unfolded. But what is known is Cain was jealous of Able, and he killed his brother. This story is found in Genesis four.

After Cain killed his brother, the Lord appeared unto Cain and asked him what he had done. Of course, the Lord was aware Cain had killed his brother, yet having no remorse, Cain asked the Lord, "Am I my brother's keeper? Genesis 4:9" So, when the Lord passed judgment upon Cain, He told Cain he would be cast out of his presence and ordered out of the Garden of Eden. Again, written in Genesis four.

Being commissioned out of the Garden, Cain was fearful for his life, as he knew those who lived outside of the Garden of Eden would want to kill him. And the reason Cain was afraid was because his family, when chosen, were put in the Garden to dress it and to keep it, Genesis 2:1. This meant his family were the Garden's caretakers, and they provided the fruit of the Garden to everyone living outside of the garden. However, once Adam disobeyed the Lord, and the tree of life was removed in that, the Lord placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life, Genesis 3:24. Hence they no longer had the fruit from this tree to provide to others, which resulted in all dying.

Additionally, thorns and weeds started growing and the eatable fruit was not as plenteous.



And because people were dying, those who resided outside of the Garden of Eden blamed God's children for their demise. Cain, knowing this, realized if he was thrown out of the presence of the Lord, he would not have the same protection.

Therefore, Cain pleaded for his life and said unto the Lord-God if he was cast out of his presence, the people outside of the Garden of Eden would want to kill him.

God is forgiving and even though Cain could no longer be established in His presence He granted Cain's life to be prolonged. For you see, God is good; whereby our Lord helps all and even causes the sun to rise and set on the good and evil. So, when the Lord sent Cain out of his presence, He disguised Cain so others would not recognize him. These stories can be found in Matthew seven verses one through three, Psalms seven, verse eight, Matthew five, verse forty-five, and Genesis four, verse fifteen.

Upon leaving the Garden of Eden, Cain traveled to Nod, where he met his wife. How far Cain had to travel to get to Nod is unclear, but I doubt it was too far perhaps only a day's journey. When created, people generally lived in the same area. I'm not sure of their transportation mode, but I suspect they had horses, camels, or mules. Yet, generally speaking, we know all human life when created was on the same continent.



However, it's unclear what type of animals lived in the same general vicinity as human beings. And the reason this is unclear is Adam named the animals that were brought to him by the Lord, Genesis 2:19. I have to presume the larger or fiercer beasts were relocated to another continent after Adam named them. So, on that day, if there had been a map of the known world, it may have looked like just one continent. They probably were not aware of any other continents. Nor did they know about Africa, where the more massive and fiercer animals had been relocated and lived. After all, it was just a little over two hundred years ago, and people still thought the earth was flat.

Noah

Now as the years and generations passed, the population began experiencing many of the same cares and problems in life that we share and bye and bye the Garden of Eden eventually faded into a dim memory.

After some years, violence began to show its ugly head, whereby; lawlessness began to rule. And it was at this point, Scripture tells us the sons of God lusted after the daughters of men Genesis 6:11, King James Bible.





What on earth does it mean when Scripture mentions the Sons of God and daughters of men? To understand what this means is to realize when God chose a people, they were heirs of Abraham, making them the sons of God. The man the Lord-God created was placed in the Garden of Eden who bore him children. If you were outside of that clan, you were created by the men of heaven and the sons of men. Thereby after many generations the children of those whom the Lord-God created; lusted after the women the men of heaven created.

So, when God established the Garden of Eden, the Lord provided Adam with one wife, and that was Eve. The decedents of Adam and Eve slept around and took as many wives as they wanted. Sexual immorality became unobstructed, which grieved the Lord God. So, when God saw the ancestors of Adam and Eve corrupting their ways, the Lord said, "The wickedness of man was great in the earth. My spirit shall not always strive with man for that he also flesh." And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart Genesis 6:1-7.

Lawlessness has to be similar to what we see in our day whereas, there was looting, rioting, and killing going on.

Consequently, where all people lived, God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually Genesis 6:5.

And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them Genesis 6:7.

Obviously, people knew about God just like everyone knows about God in this day. However, like the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation Jude 1:6. So was this generation.

However, during those days, there was a man named Noah and he found grace in the eyes of the Lord Genesis 6:8. And the Lord said unto Noah, "The end of all flesh has come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them, and behold, I will destroy them with the earth. Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch Genesis 6:13-14".

Noah believed what the Lord God said and did accordingly. And it is my understanding, the Ark was approximately 450 feet long and 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high. To put this in perspective, an Ark, the size of a football field? When a football field is 360 feet long, and 160 feet wide.

What animals were taken aboard the Ark is questionable as the food had to last forty days. Yet, what we do know is, The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth Prv 3:19, 20. And what I want to point out here is wisdom. Consequently, the reason, I have to believe the larger and more ferocious animals had to have been relocated to another continent by the Lord after Adam named them, Genesis 2:20.

Besides this the Lord told Noah, "To Take of every living thing of all flesh, two of every sort shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee, they shall be male and female.

Genesis 6:19" Yet cows, chickens, and animals that were for human consumption; Noah was told to take seven of each kind, Genesis 7:2.

For you see, Noah had to gather food for both the animals and his family. And the more animals, the more food had to be taken aboard—as it had to last forty days. So, it makes sense if there had been carnivore animals, like lions, Noah would have had to have taken even more animals.

Then, once Noah had finished building the Ark and gathering all the animals, the Lord said unto Noah, "Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation Genesis 7:1". And all other people drowned after Noah and his family entered the Ark.

As mentioned, we can't be sure what animals were aboard the Ark: yet, when we look around, we see the difference in our ethnicity. Thereby, we know someone in Noah's family was black, yellow, brown, and white.


Once they departed, the Ark people began to prosper and multiply. After some generations passed, humans began to repopulate the earth. During which time, the ancestors of Noah all spoke the same language. Whereby, all people were of one language, and of one speech, Genesis 11:9.

Then for reasons unknown, there came a time the entire population decided to venture and travel from the areas they populated. We don't know the circumstances or reasons they chose to relocate. But when they moved, they journeyed from the east, where they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there Genesis 11:2.

Babylon

They heard stories of the flood. Yet the descendants of Noah, like people in our day are knowledgeable regarding this cataclysm. Yet, being knowledgeable about something doesn't mean you believe it, in your heart.

After traveling a good distance, they decided to put their roots down in the place they named Shinar. However, they were confused and somewhat bewildered because traveling they didn't find any other living beings. Consequently, they decided to leave a footprint and name for themselves. Whence they said, "Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth," Genesis 11:3-4.



So even back then when traveling to a new place they were perplexed when they were unable to find other humans beings along the way. And they wondered if there is a God who created life, what was the reason, he made only them? Just like many in this day who build space ships and fly to heaven in search of other life. They too can't understand how we can be the only lifeform that exists.

Invariably the Lord came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men built. And the Lord said to the men of heaven, "Behold, the people is one. and they have all one language, and this they begin to do; and now nothing will be restrained from them Genesis 11:5-7."

At this time, the Lord continued telling those in the Kingdom of heaven, "Let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech" Gn 11:7. So, from that time on, when those in heaven came down, they confounded everyone's language by ethnicity. As exemplified in our day, yellow people began speaking Japanese, while others started speaking Chinese, so on, and so forth. How the Lord-God accomplished this feat is a mystery. But it was also at this time, the Lord gave the city a new name Babylon because they were confused and could no longer understand each other's speech.

However, everyone still colonized the same continent so those who spoke English began congregating in one area; those who spoke French assembled elsewhere. Some began speaking Swahili massed in other regions, while people who spoke Spanish gathered in different areas, and so forth.





All of us had an ancestor get off the same boat, being the Ark, regardless of skin color, nationality, where you live in this world, how much money you have, or even how much money you don't have. All of these things have been, and there is nothing new under the sun.



Knowing God and Jesus Chapter 2

Let's say you haven't met someone but heard about their personality traits. This is all you could explain to others, right? However, when you meet someone. You are able to explain their appearance, hair color, how tall they are, etc. So metaphorically speaking this chapter will explain who God and Jesus are.

So, to begin with and to understand who Jesus and who God is, we will have to look into another dimension. First Corinthians starting in chapter fifteen in verse twelve, explains a human body can be either celestial or terrestrial. A terrestrial person is of the earth while a heavenly person would be from heaven; they look similar, yet somehow, each is different 1 Corinthians 15:40.



What I want you to understand is we look like those in heaven. As even Geneses explains we were created in God's image. God speaking to the angels in heaven said: "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness, Genesis 1:26". And we can find many stories in Scripture that reveal heavenly beings resemble humans.

An example of how men from heaven appear as those of us on earth was when Jacob was alienated from his brother Esau. As a boy, Jacob had hijacked Esau's birthright causing Jacob to be estranged from his brother. Jacob knew Esau was angry with him, so he fled his native land and worked for a man called Laban. Laban was a harsh taskmaster, but the Lord blessed Jacob. Laban used Jacob like a slave, yet Jacob prospered, and he gained most of Laban's wealth. Jacob acquiring most of Laban's livestock angered Laban's sons, who wanted vengeance.

Yet, the Lord was with Jacob and told him to return to his homeland. Returning home Jacob was concerned Esau would hold a grudge against him and want to kill him. Even though this concerned him, he did as the Lord commanded and traveled back to his hometown.



As Jacob traveled home, he met up with a group of angels or that being messengers from heaven Genesis 32:1, Genesis 32:24. Later that night, Jacob wrestle one of those men which turned out to be an angel.

Apparently in those days, men would bestow a blessing on others they challenged. When Jacob realized the type of blessing, he received he knew it could only be given to him by God's angel and not a man from earth, Genesis 32.


Another story of how men of heaven appear as those of us on earth was when the angels came to Sodom and warned Lot of the impending destruction of Sodom and Gamora. In appearance they were as two men whom he met at the gate of the city yet they were angels from heaven, Genesis 19.

And on top of all that the New Testament tells us to entertain strangers as we too could be visited by someone from heaven, yet they obviously would appear as a human being Hebrew 13:2.

So, by all of these examples found in Scripture we know those in heaven appear like men and not wind.

The reason this is important to understand is because after Jesus was crucified his grave was empty. And after he rose from the grave, the apostles touched him and even ate with him Luke 24:31-43. So, like those in heaven we know Christ also has a celestial body and in appearance looks like a human being.





However, Christ explained God is a Spirit which may sound a bid spooky but in reality, we are all a spirit/ghost/worm incased in a body John 4:24. So if you can receive this or not. God is a ghost and a lifeform that is invisible and this is the reason no one has ever seen God John 1:18.

Hence the makeup of a spiritual person from heaven is to use an illustration of an egg whereas an egg has three different components, John 3:13. What I mean is the shell is like our body, the white of the egg is like our spirit, and being possessed by God we have a yoke that is fertilized meaning the Spirit of God is within us. Hence our body is the temple that God's Holy Spirit resides in.

While a person born amongst men is like an egg that doesn't have a yoke. Or if this person is possessed by another spirit, he may have a yoke but it is not fertilized.

Next those who receive Christ are all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit 1 Corinthians 12:13." So now we want to examine how the Holy Spirit is assembled and how He is one Spirit. I will use an example of a tree because everyone knows the tree's power is in its root. As the root of the tree determines what fruit, leaves, and flowers the tree will bear. The meaning of God is to know His portion of the Spirit is where all the power lies. Hence the Father is like the tree's root, while the rest of his body (Holy Spirit) is like the tree.

And understanding how the Spirit of God is connected yet His Spirit has separate appendages. Or like we know the root and the tree are one yet separate. Likewise, so is the Spirit of God.

A saint of God receiving the Holy Spirit would receive a portion of the Spirit. Or using the above example it would be like a leaf from the tree would enter into them. Hence their body becomes the temple of God. One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all Ephesians 4:6.

And if you are able to understand how those of heaven are connected to the Father via His Holy Spirit. You should be able to understand how the story of Christ unfolds. For you see: In the beginning, was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same (Jesus) was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him, and without him was not anything made that was made John 1.

So, when God created the earth, Christ was directed by the supreme portion of God's Holy Spirit in him saying: "Let there be light, Genesis 1:3", and it was so. In other words, God our Father in Christ spoke and the words God pronounced through Christ came into being. Don't you see? God, is a Spirit and He does not change into what He communicates, but what he articulates comes into existence.

Then when Christ was born it came about in this fashion, whereas God's Spirit spoke and said, "Let my beloved Son be born flesh". Hence, the angel of God came unto Mary and explained how the Holy Ghost, which is Christ's Father, would come upon her and she would be with child, Luke 1:35. Thereby, after God's word was spoken unto Mary, she was found with child.

At which point Jesus a celestial being in heaven, changed form, and became an embryo implanted in Mary. The portion of God's Holy Spirit that had been in Christ was the sovereign portion of God's Spirit, which is the Father. He was in Christ and upon Christ's birth He departed Christ's body and stayed in heaven.

Thereby, Christ was born a terrestrial man and was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin, Hebrew 4:15. On the other hand, God cannot be tempted by evil as Jesus was.

Another reason you should realize God could not become flesh as many proclaim! James 1:13.

Now when Jesus was born, Palestine was ruled by king Herod the Great. He was known for his great building projects and his ruthlessness. During that day, they rebuilt Jerusalem along with the temple. Even though it was a perplexing time.

The religious understood the book of Daniel, how it explained the rebuilding of the city and temple would take sixty years, and the Messiah would come Daniel 9:25. The Jews that believed the Book of Daniel; expected Christ to appear and were being baptized by John the Baptist. As it is written in the prophets, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee, Mark 1:2-4.

Then after Christ had grown up and right before he started preaching his message Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan. And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him: And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. And immediately the spirit driveth him into the wilderness, Mark 1:9-12.

This Scripture reveals when Christ was baptized by John the Baptist the Holy Spirit ascended and entered into Jesus.

This Scripture also reveals the Father spoke from heaven unto those at the river Jordan. Revealing what portion of God's Spirit entered Christ.

Whereby, Jesus received the body portion of God's Holy Spirit while the Father portion of His Spirit stayed in heaven. And staying with the above example; Christ received the tree and all its leaves (Holy Spirit) while the root (Father) stayed in heaven.

Once Christ had finished telling us what the Father gave him to reveal, most of the population hated him and crucified him upon the cross. While Christ was in the grave for three days, his body went through a life cycle known as a complete metamorphosis. Similar to what a butterfly would experience. Consequently, his earthly body changed back into the heavenly. He put on immortality, and the rebirth (born again) took witness. Thereby, born again Christ was resurrected and his grave was empty, 1 Corinthians 15:51-54.



Prior to his crucifixion Christ revealed in a prayer he made public saying: "And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was, Jn 17:5." Revealing, once entering back into heaven he would receive the highest-ranking portion of God's Holy Spirit. Whereby God glorified Jesus with himself. Hence the portion of God's Spirit (the Father) entered back into Jesus upon his resurrection. This too is why Jesus is the Messiah. For Christ loved.


righteousness, and hated wickedness. Therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows, Psalm 45:7.

Jesus told us he that hath seen me hath seen the Father, John 14:9. And this again, was because when Jesus rose back into heaven. the Father anointed him with himself. Meaning the portion of God's Spirit (the Father) entered back into Christ. Of course, you can't see God due to the fact He is a Spirit but have the realization Jesus is like two people in one body. In other words, Christ is the temple of our Father's Spirit, because to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him 1 Corinthians 8:6.

Then when we turn to Christ and receive a portion of the Holy Spirit it's something we can feel and see. And that was why Christ said, at that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you John 14:20.

However, this too was the reason the apostles couldn't receive God's Spirit until Christ had risen. Because the Holy Spirit (tree portion) had taken residence in Jesus when He walked upon earth.





So once Christ rose back into heaven, He received the Father and the Holy Spirit that was in him is now dispersed unto his apostles. Whereby he is in us and we receive Jesus. John 14:20

So, you see, our body is the temple where God's Spirit dwells. Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within us, Luke 17:21. Possessed by God's Spirit, we are two people in one body, which is the marriage of the lamb.

Obviously if you don't believe Christ's testimony that God is a Spirit, you deny who God is and that He resides in Christ. Thereby, who is a liar? Jesus said: "He that hath seen me hath seen the Father, John 14:9. Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? Don't you know, he is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son 1 John 2:22.

The Reason God Created Mankind Chapter 3


This chapter addresses the question of why God created humankind.

Thus saith the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me. I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded Isaiah 45: 11,12

I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron: And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the Lord, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel, Isaiah 45: 2,3.

I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded, Isaiah 45:12.

For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the Lord; and there is none else, Isaiah 45:18



So, Christ, by way of God [his maker], created the world, yet it was not in vain. Thereby, we know there had to have been a reason.

However, it is written, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created Revelation 4:11.

And because of this one verse, many people assume we are like toys you make for kids. They think when you succeed in life, this is for God's pleasure. And the rest of the population is doomed?

Proving this type of theology is incorrect we find a story, Christ said in Luke sixteen, verses nineteen through twenty-three. The story is about a rich man who had plenty of goods stored up while a beggar named Lazarus lay at his gate, full of sores. The beggar desired the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover, the dogs came and licked his sores. Both men died, and the rich man went to hell while the Lord brought Lazarus to heaven.




Obviously, God does not get pleasure from people suffering, and it is for this reason we know God didn't create humankind like some wind-up toy.

So, find what Revelation four verse eleven meant you have to first understand there is a chain of command in heaven like captains, sergeants, and other officers. However, the portion of the Spirit that is in Christ makes Christ the Commander in Chief as explained in First Corinthians eleven, chapter three. And as Christ said: to sit on my right hand and on my left hand is not mine to give; but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared Mark 10:40.

What I am trying to, explain is how the Kingdom of God is fashioned. And by using a military phrase to explain the chain of command I want you to know that our weapons are not carnal. So, unlike those of this world, we don't have guns and munitions like others deem necessary. For you see, Wisdom is better than weapons of war: Ecclesiastes 9:18.

By faith alone and not owning weapons I want stress how powerful God's Word is.





As previously revealed, we know it was through faith that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. Hebrew 11:3. Whereas, God in Christ spoke and the earth was created. Upon earth Christ and the apostles raised the sick by the Word that God gave them. Christ rose the dead by the Word God gave him. Elijah called fire down from heaven by God's Word. Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent Exodus 7:10. Hence this too was done by God's Word and what He told them to do.

Or when the children of Israel were still fighting over real estate, we know in the book of Joshua chapter six verses one through twenty-seven. Whereas, the Lord commanded the children of Israel to march around the city seven times and blow trumpets. And after they did what the Lord commanded the walls of Jerico fell.

Even in these last days when God's Word is spoken, we know the end result is the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. 2 Peter 3:7

And by knowing all of this we realize the Word God gives us are the weapons of our warfare, and they are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds; 2 Corinthians 10:4. Therefore we are told if people believe us or not to: Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long suffering and doctrine 2 Peter 4:2.

So, by all of this we know the blood of Christ cleanses us from our sin but the power is in His Word.

Next, to enable you to understand the reason God created mankind you'll have to realize a person can receive the Holy Spirit but it is not a guarantee of being saved. Even the letters to the churches in Revelation verify this so it is a must to understand when there is deceit found in a person the Spirit of God can leave them.

And the reason this is important to understand is because apparently prior to the earth being created Satan in heaven disagreed with our commander in chief, which is Christ. It appears Satan wanted to take Christ's position. At which point, the devil and his angels became traitors and wanted to take heaven by storm. They disagreed with God's Word, authority, rule, and started some sort of a revolution.

At that time, the Holy Spirit resided in these renegade angels, and their disobedience grieved the Holy Spirit that was in them. And to fully understand how God's Holy Spirit can inhabit a disobedient person and leave that person. All you have to do is read the story of King Saul.

How the story of King Saul went was when Israel was still fighting the nations around them. They also wanted to be like other nations and have a monarchy.

At first, King Saul served the Lord, insomuch he was blessed by the Lord, and the Holy Spirit entered into Saul.

There was some sort of skirmish going on, and Samuel, the prophet, commanded Saul via the Spirit of God, to wait upon the Lord. Samuel was running late, and Saul wanted the adoration of people more than God. Not having faith, neither trusting what the Lord commanded him to do via Samuel, he became impatient and decided to do things his way. At which point, the Spirit of the Lord departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the Lord troubled him 1 Samuel 16: 14. The entire story can be read in first Samuel chapters thirteen through sixteen.

Another story of how God's Spirit can leave a person is found in the New Testament. It was when the apostles established the true church. The church was a commune, and everyone pitched in all their money which was then distributed amongst all. This way no one lacked for anything.

What took place is, Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet Acts 5: 1,2.

But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God Acts 5:3,4.

And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things, Acts 5:5.

Then Peter approached the man's wife, and said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out. Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband, Acts 5: 9,10.

Carried to their graves, the Ghost or that being the Spirit of God departed out of them. Whereas Ananias and his wife dropped dead. And of a truth, "It is a fearful and terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God Hebrews 10:31", because He doesn't play church.

Paul told the true Church when a person seeks to do evil to hand this person over to Satan. And the way this was explained in Scripture, whereas it was reported commonly that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife 1 Corinthians 5:1.

He stated how the Church was puffed up and didn't mourn this behavior 1 Corinthians 5:2.



He told them: For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed, In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, 1 Corinthians 5: 3-4.

Paul for sure wasn't an ear scratcher trying to win the hearts of people to himself. But a soldier for our Lord and he was against evil when it was found in a person. Paul told the true church: To deliver this person over to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus 1 Corinthians 5:5. Paul meant the Holy Spirit could be returned unto the Lord as these people were turned over to Satan.


Don't you realize, those who follow Satan's deeds will in no way get into God's Kingdom? Due to the gate into the Kingdom of God is narrow and they will not sneak nor be coerced.

Even today many don't mourn evil behavior but claim when you follow Christ's commandments it is to gain heaven by works. What are they saying? When a person wants to do as Christ taught this is a chore and not an act of love? I mean, what theology do people believe? After all, God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, Peter 2:4. So why would people think they are greater than the angels of heaven?

In any case, prior to the world being created a revolt had ensued in heaven and the Spirit of God departed out of these disobedient angels. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and the dragon fought and his angels. And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him Revelation 12: 7-9.

And it was during this time earth created was in its infancy. At which point the Lord-God had also created living creatures that hath life, and foul that may fly above the earth in the opening ferment of heaven, And God created every creature that moves Genesis 1:20. The opening firmament of heaven sounds like the heavens and earth were still in agitation and growth. And apparently, it was at this time the dinosaurs were created. We call them dinosaurs, but obviously, the Bible refers to them as dragons.


The obedient angels of heaven captured these disobedient beings and cast them unto the earth. Upon earth, they didn't have fruit from the tree of life, like the tree of life growing in Eden and found in heaven, Revelation 22:2. Thereby, their glorious bodies could not sustain life, and they too turned into dust.

Consequently, what is important to understand at this point, is the meaning of death. For Christ admitted if we lose our body the soul would not die but it is capable of being thrown into hell, Mark 9:44. And to fully understand this you have to remember those from heaven are fashioned like the example of the egg. Because the meaning of death is when you're not born again and don't have a celestial body which is the temple for the Spirit of God to dwell Jn 3, 1 Corinthians 15:40-44. Hence like Adam and Eve died and turned into dust, thereby having no body (temple). Whereby death means you suffer separation from God's Holy Spirit.

Or like explained we too are like a soul/spirit/worm incased in a body.

So, when Satan and his renegade angels were cast unto earth their bodies turned into dust and their spirits (souls) began to wander like a bacterium unable to find rest. And they began their journey; of going to and fro in the earth, walking up and down in it, Job 1:7. And as an unclean spirit walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none Matthew 12:43, Luke 11:24.

Having insomnia and seeking rest, they inhabited these fantastic beasts, the dinosaurs—kind of like when Satan entered a heard of swine after Christ cast him out of a man. Or like the devil inhabited a serpent when he deceived Eve. In fact, this is the reason in Revelation; he earned the nickname of a snake, a great dragon, and a beast.




How the dinosaurs were destroyed is not recorded as no one was made privy to this. Nonetheless, dinosaurs became a stumbling block as they caused many to disbelieve in the Lord and our God.

However, we know once these beasts were annihilated, the Lord God created humankind upon the earth and not again angels in heaven.

The world then became the court where God tries the human soul.

Christ referred to this time as the regeneration in Matthew nineteen verse twenty-eight as the Kingdom of God was being made new. For it was at this time, the Lord-God began drafting people into His kingdom. However, strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it. Matthew 7:14.

For you see, Scripture explains in Jeremiah seventeen verse nine and ten how: The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it? I the Lord search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings.



In other words, when God created humans', everyone was given two eyes to see, ears to hear, a mouth to talk. But the Lord wants to find out what motivates us as individuals. In fact, this was the reason the forbidden tree was in the Garden of Eden. As the Lord God wanted to know what made Adam and Eve tick.

In our day, God knows the depths of one's heart by the way we interpret Scripture. And that is the reason I liken the Bible to an inkblot test a psychiatrist developed, insomuch, by our interpretation it discloses to God Almighty the intent of one's heart. Thereby, those who are covetous will read greed, a lair will not see the truth, "but those with an honest and good heart, having heard the Word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience, Luke 8:15".

And to sum this up, the reason God created humankind and not more beings in heaven was so the heart could be tried.

Hence the question has never been does God love you but do you love him?

To Understand Scripture Chapter 4





Solomon explains by the Spirit of God in Proverbs that "A wicked doer will give heed to false lips, and a liar will give ear to a mischievous tongue Proverbs 17:4." Telling us, if we follow those who have not heard His word correctly, we can't claim to be victims, as we have to take responsibility for our actions, Matthew 15:14. Just like Eve who listened to the serpent by disobeying God's commandment and ate from the forbidden tree. After which she tried to blame the snake. Or Adam who gave heed to his wife and ate of the forbidden fruit and he tried to blame Eve. Yet they both died because they had to take responsibility for what they chose to believe, hear, and follow.

On top of that, I realize the time has come when people refuse sound doctrine; but after their own lusts heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from the truth, 2 Timothy 4:3-4.

But for me I choose to: love the Lord my God with all my heart, and with all my soul, and with all my mind. Therein I seek the Lord's will to be done over my own. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. Matthew 22:37-40.

Hence religion is a way of life as it is a relationship with the Lord God and how we treat our fellowman.

Will there be any faith?

As for me, I am not a religious organization, nor can I tell you to go here or go there as I have no altar to walk down. For I only come in the name of the Lord and can say HE IS, and it is him you have to believe. This entire book is written with the King James version of the Word of God and are not my words in hopes that you understand it is not how I judge anyone.

In the previous chapters, we have looked at the reason God created mankind and the reason it was a narrow gate into the Kingdom of God.

So first I want to insert After Christ was crucified, the true church was being slaughtered. Paul being held in prison for preaching the truth of Christ was given the book of Revelation. Revelation is the revealing of the truth and how this world comes to its end.

Revelation starts with a letter to the churches warning us that no one is above judgement.

You will have to understand judgment has to start with those who are true believers. Hence, we find the letters written to the churches in Revelation two through four.

Even after turning to Christ, we will have failures. And repenting from our failures does not mean we totally escape discipline due to God is a just God. As Hebrews twelve verses seven and eight explains: If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. But we know If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Now Christ revealed after people are made aware and know the truth of God, "There will be weeping, and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but you yourselves thrust out Luke 13:28." Telling us once the Lord adequately rebuilt the Kingdom of God, there will be a great tribulation.

I look at the tribulation as a spanking a child would receive. After all, everyone owes their existence to heaven. And who has a child you don't correct when they have done wrong? When you correct a child, it is because you love them. Right? So, I genuinely hope you hear.

When Noah entered the Ark and the rains began to fall, I'm sure people were at the door of the Ark wanting in. And the only difference between then and now is Jesus. For you see

Christ prayed for those who refused his doctrine saying: "forgive them for they know not what they do" Luke 23:34 as He realized they couldn't see themselves for the creature (soul) was made subject to vanity Romans 8:20.

Consequently, what I know is we are in the last days, and the world we inhabit will pass away in a ball of flames never to rise again. The earth's poles are shifting, entire towns destroyed by fire and floods. Not to mention there is distress of nations with perplexity Luke 21:25. Yet it is promised there shall be, a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. Revelation 21:1. Sure, the gate into God's Kingdom was narrow, and our Lord wished all would have sought to enter therein but for reasons revealed were unable to.

Yet and still, because God is love and forgiving. Hence, we know the reason John saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God Revelation

15:2. Thereby there will be many who come through this great tribulation and be saved.



The people saved would consist of a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands Revelation 7:9.

At which point those who see will be, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb, Revelation 7:10.

And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God Revelation 7:11.

Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honor, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen, Revelation 7:12.

And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, "What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they, Revelation 7:13?"


And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, "These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb, Revelation 7:14.



And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox Isaiah 11:7.





And the new world had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it, Revelation 21: 23-24.

Plus, we find in the kingdom of Heaven "In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations Revelation 22:2." As Adam provided fruit to those outside of Eden's Garden, Heaven will provide fruit and healing to those saved on this new earth.

Therefore, I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people. Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters, Revelation 14:6, 7.



The judgement coming it is realized: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and notable day of the Lord come: Acts 2:20.


Whereas the Lord will show wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: Acts 2:19

The previous chapters explained who the Lord is. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord (in truth) shall be saved. Acts 2:21.

And he that sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful, Revelation 21:5."

The Beast and Mystery Babylon

To find the beast and mystery Babylon you'll need to realize the reason Revelation was penned in riddles and a conundrum to understand. It was because the abandonment of the truth had already begun and the mysteries of heaven were hidden.

However, the book of Revelation is now being revealed to the world in this last day, Matthew 13:11, Revelation 14:6.

So, to begin with we find in Scripture when the true church was in its infancy, many came to hear Paul preach the gospel of Christ. However, Paul explained many listening to him were imposters. He warned how they would become apostate theologians, and would not spare the true church. As they would in fact, speak headstrong theology and be against what Christ taught. Paul had to have realized they were obviously covetous and their goal was to make merchandise out of people and get followers to follow them. This story can be found in Acts twenty, verses thirty, and thirty-one.

Then once the true church had expanded it was noted, the mystery of iniquity was already at work 2 Thes 2:7. And God allowed this to happen until the last day. Consequently, the truth of Christ had been abandoned by many and a watered-down doctrine started raising its head.





And all of this began to take place two thousand years ago. However, we were also warned if someone came and preached another Jesus, whom the apostles had not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, or another gospel, then we would have to bear with him.

So, I hope you're able to understand this chapter.

As it is one thing to sin which all of us are guilty of, but another thing to be governed by evil's depths. Even Christ warned us to be wary of religious leaders as even in his day, they appeared like whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness Mth 23:27. The reason this is important to understand is because a con artist has to appear good to deceive, and Satan is the biggest con of all.

And it is for this reason we want to take a look at an example of people who are governed by the depths of depravity. Wouldn't you say serial killers fit this description? And if you knew a religious leader was conveying lies to his flock, causing them to die and end up in hell wouldn't you consider this leader a serial killer?

Explanation of what Revelation is telling us:

Revelation seventeen and thirteen tells us a perplexing story. And to paraphrase what it forewarns and says: is there are two beasts that come to power.

The way the story unfolds in Revelation is the first beast will suffer a head wound and appears dead when a second beast with two horns emerges on the scene. The second beast acquires all the first beast's power and helps to heal the first beast's head wound.

And if that isn't confusing enough when the second beast arrives on the scene, he has a number for his name; which is 666.

The beast also has seven heads which are mountains.

And to top it all off, there is a woman who is sitting on this beast known as Mystery Babylon.

The Seven Heads on the Beast which are Mountains

First, we want to find the veiled meaning for the seven heads: Whereas, John saw a beast rise up out of the sea, and it had seven heads with ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy" Revelation 13:1.

So, to uncover what John saw you will need to realize: The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth, Revelation 17: 8-9.

Additionally, in other Scripture we were told when Satan was cast out of heaven he went about to deceive, the whole world, Revelation 12:9.

Putting this puzzle together we realize when Satan was cast out of heaven, he lost his glorious celestial body and as an evil spirit deceives the entire world. The world has seven continents that are actually mountains. I mean, if you could visualize a continent rising out of the sea, you would know it is a huge mountain, right? Hence the seven heads of this beast are the seven continents of this world, and those who inhabit this world are those whom Satan deceives.


The Beast Revealed

Then as revealed, when Satan was cast out of heaven, because he had lost his celestial body as an evil spirit, he used men whom he inhabits to deceive the entire world. Now the reason Satan wanted to deceive the world was because he knew when God found those who loved him. The devil knew his end would come. Hence the beast is an evil spirit in Revelation. And to prove this is true, when Jesus walked amongst men he healed people, and cast out many evil spirits that had possessed and deceived the children of men.

One example of spirit possession was when, Jesus was in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, the spirit in this man cried out with a loud voice, saying, Leave us alone; what do we have to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? have you come to destroy us? I know you are; the Holy One of God. At which point Jesus rebuked him, saying, hold thy peace, and then cast the evil spirit out of him. Lk 4: 33-35.

After this had happened and later that day, when the sun was setting, many sick people were brought unto Christ; and Jesus laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them. And those who were possessed by devils were cast out. Christ rebuking these evil spirits, forbid them to speak: for they knew that he was Christ, Lk 4: 40-41, Mt 8:16. So you see, evil spirits in people will confess Christ is the Son of God but obviously they don't follow much less believe his teachings.

Now the religious leaders in Christ's day were skeptical of the fact that they could be possessed by evil spirits. As they were self-righteous and did good works like feeding the poor, etc. And they wouldn't accept Christ revealing the fact of spirit possession or anything else he taught. Whereas we are made aware to the fact that they walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Eph 2:2. Also it was for this reason Jesus told them




Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. And because I tell you the truth, ye believe me not.

There are many other Scriptures that reveal the existence of this evil spirit. And whether people believe in this presentation of the Bible or not, the beast is an evil spirit and the devil mentioned in Revelation! Thereby as an evil spirit, he goes about devouring and deceiving those whom he can. And it is for this reason we wrestle not against flesh and blood (people), but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness Eph 6:12.

Revelation Revealed

Next, we find the passion translation explains when Christ walked amongst men Satan an evil spirit in men cried out shouting at Jesus saying; "Son of God, what do you want with us? Leave us alone! Have you come to torment us before the appointed time? Mth 8:29". Revealing Satan obviously new his time had not yet come.


So, when Christ was born and walked amongst the Jews. He taught the way we should live our lives but also revealed the depths of darkness found in this world. Thereby bringing in the beginning of the end of this world. By Christ being obedient to God unto death, he defeated Satan which allowed Revelation to be penned Hebrews 5:8. And Revelation is the book of the Bible which reveals the judgement and how this world ends. Revelation 5.



Having the knowledge Christ brought. Revealed how evil spirits were capable of possessing human beings. If you are able to believe Christ then you should be able to realize the first player or, as Revelation explained the "first beast", would have been the Roman Empire. The Roman Empire ruled the world with an iron hand. They didn't accept Christ's teachings of evil spirits possessing them and they were in the throes of Satan. They followed their own philosophies and once Christ was crucified; they persecuted the true Christians and committed genocide against them. Even Revelation was penned in prison.

Revelation explains the first beast mentioned would suffer a head wound and appear dead, yet he would survive. So, one continent (being one of his heads) was diffused and appeared dead. This of course was the Roman Empire (Europe).


Then as the Roman Empire began fading away, a second beast (people possessed by another spirit) began their rise to power.



Rise of the 2nd Beast

Now we want to find the second spiritual entity that rose to power and to do this we realize we have to find a man whose number is 666. I think everyone has heard about the man of sin representing this beast and how he would have a number for his name.

We don't want to take off on some tangent but we want to investigate all of Scripture to be sure we grasp the truth. The first thing I found in the gospels is Christ warned us in Matthew twenty-four to: Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. Thereby preaching another Jesus 2 Cor 11:14. In other words, the apostasy would rise up claiming Jesus is the Christ and they would deceive many people.



On top of that Revelation explains this another way by saying an evil spirit being the second beast that rises up would have two horns like a lamb Rv 13:11. Scripture reveals Christ is the lamb of God, Jn 1:29. Thereby this verse exposes the second beast that rose would be two entities that would use Jesus in name only. Although these two creatures may appear like their preaching Jesus but they will speak like a dragon Rv 13:11. Thereby it has to be apparent they would be like the religions in Christ day, self-righteous claiming they could save everyone yet ferocious in speech.

And to enable us to find that man of sin who started this mess we must have, understanding and count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six Rv 13:18". If you have understanding you will be able to comprehend how a number can represent a person. As an example, you did not exist before your birth date hence your name was not known to your family. Or let's say you ran for president but prior to that time no one knew about you nor did they know your name. And it is for this reason we have to find out when a person was born or when they took a specific office making their name known to the world. Understanding this we know the number of this man had to be 6/6/06, or 6/66. As this would have been when this man was born or when he began to take power. Hence by his position and theology he indoctrinated and deceived the entire world.



The person I found was Pope Linus. He came into power AD 67 and must have been considered for his role 6/66. The Catholics changed the calendar so it is no wonder if they changed any dates. In any case, it was at this time the Catholic Church and their doctrine was made known to the world showing herself to the world as the leader unto the savior.

Yet, they are against Christ and everything he taught.
Whereas they wear long robes, call their preacher father, and built statues of those whom they killed.
After which they pray to the statues and to the queen of heaven. Even writing their own Bible.

Then after some years Constantine was the first Roman Emperor to adopt the Catholic Religion. Consequently, Constantine knew by flirting with religion it would help with governing. As he also realized they needed help in times of war and strife.

Now Christ had warned saying when: Ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows Mth 24:7. All of which progressed throughout the years if it was the bubonic plague, yellow fever, AIDS, and recently Covid. Not to forget the many wars that eventually resulted even escalating into WW I and WW II.





When the Catholics and politics merged, they took control and the inquisition enforced Orthodox Catholic's to became the official religion. And according to history, the Inquisition was a powerful office set up within the Catholic Church to root out and punish heresy throughout Europe and the Americas. I mean who could stand a heretic? After all the truth explained a narrow gate while the Catholic's claimed, they could redeem everyone. And as Christ forewarned Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake Mt 24:9.

The Catholic's claimed to be the saviors of the new world and if anyone contended with them, they were considered a heretic. Self-righteous and above sin they moved forth like a dragon and people were tortured and killed. Books were burned. Whereas nobody could buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name, Revelation 13:17. Talk about the dark ages as all of this lasted for over six hundred years yet people are still looking for this time to come???

As the years progressed as chameleon, they went from being the aggressor to claiming they were the persecuted. Even claiming Paul was their first Pope and Linus was the second. Hence, it was given unto him (this evil spirit in people) to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations Rv 13:7.

Then as explained this apostate faith (beast) would have seven heads. Whereas it was revealed they went about to deceive the entire world.

I think what needs to be understood is prophecy in Scripture isn't like instant soup you put in the microwave. And the reason this is important to understand is because the second horn on this beast did not pop up instantly but it became apparent as the years progressed. Whereas we are able to find two opposing faiths that preach another Jesus but claim to worship the same god. In fact, not knowing God is a Spirit they claim to have three gods which are the father, son, and holy ghost.

Then history reveals during the days of Martin Luther, the protestants were victims of this Catholic charade. The Protestants were finally able to get out of the grips of the Catholics' but still held to their gods. And I have to wonder, by them proclaiming to worship the same gods, if this was the reason the Catholics terminated persecuting them?

I don't know enough about Martin Luther to comment whether he was a true apostle of God and people evolved in another direction to appease the Catholics? But what I know is the Catholic faith became a mother to the apostate Christian faiths.

And I hope you see, because to us, "There is only one God, the Father of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him. 1 Corinthians 8:6. Scripture reveals Christ was raised from the grave as celestial being. His grave was empty and he did not turn into a pillar of dust like Adam and Eve. And it is for this reason I have hope and know who my God is.

Nonetheless I am reminded of Adam and Eve. The serpent had to have explained to Eve how he was without a body yet he was able to still be alive. But if we follow Christ in life, wouldn't we follow him in death too. Otherwise, where is the assurance of our hope?

Thereby it is also your choice as to whom you believe! Christ who rose from the grave in a celestial body. Satan on the other hand who lost his celestial body and as a spirit deceives many.

Then when the Lord-God confronted them. Adam blamed Eve and Eve blamed the snake. Making me realize everyone will have to take responsibility of whom they follow and whom they chose to believe.

Mystery Babylon and the Woman

The next few short chapters are going to explains the reason for Mystery Babylon's harsh judgement. Revealing how she caused people to worship the first beast (an evil spirit) and how the governments of this world were formed as well as their demise.

The way all of this is written in Revelation seventeen is: And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters:

- ² With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
- ³ So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.
- ⁴ And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:
- ⁵ And upon her forehead was a name written, Mystery, Babylon The Great, The Mother Of Harlots And Abominations Of The Earth.

⁶ And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

⁷ And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns.

First of all, Genesis in Scripture explains when God confused their language, He named the city Babylon because nobody could understand each other's speech. Then as religion became a conglomerate of theology confusing people as to what truth was. She spread her wings throughout the entire world. Giving us the understanding and reason why in Revelation she was named Babylon.



Whereas it is written upon her forehead, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration Revelation 17:5, 6. Previous chapter revealed how the inquisition lasted six hundred years.

And by their own words they declare there is no need to follow Christ's teaching as that is a chore (work), and will wallow in sin screaming the blood and not the love.

Next, we want to find the abomination of desolation Christ mentioned in Matthew twenty-four. Scripture says: When you shall see; The abomination of desolation stand in the Holy place then let those who are in Judea flea to the mountains Mk 13:14, Matthew 24: 15,16.

And to find the abomination of desolation you will need to realize in 70 CE the Roman Empire reclaimed Jerusalem and destroyed the Second Temple with only a portion of the western wall remaining. Ssubsequently it was at that time they sacrificed a pig upon its altar.


However, during the day of Christ, the apostles spoke to him about that same temple. Upon which time Christ warned how that temple would be destroyed. And this would be when the apostasy would begin its rise.

Now the way this is written in Scripture Jesus explained after that temple's destruction: People shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not Mth 24:26.

Back then Pope Linus appeared on the scene, he claimed to the world all go to heaven as long as you weren't a hectic meaning you had to follow them. Throughout the years they proclaimed they were capable to lead everyone to Christ enforcing religion on all. They insisted on teaching religion in schools causing the indoctrination and brainwashing of even the children. Even in this day we find many people who claim they can lead you to Christ down their alters, etc.

On the other hand, true Christian faith, doesn't enforce their beliefs on anyone. If a person hears they hear. If not, it is between them and God. After all Satan was cast out of heaven and he in no way will sneak, much less be coerced back in.

As an example, I am capable to explain the greatness of God and how if you have faith in Him a mountain can move. In other words, you don't have to worry about what you will eat or wear as God is great in power and will take care of all your needs. Sure, I as a Christian can give you a shirt if you don't have one or a plate of food if you are hungry. But if you believe in Him and have faith you have no need of me playing God and supporting you.

We also know by telling the truth of the gospel given to us that for the most part the world will hate us as Christ proclaimed in Jn 15: 18,19. That in itself can be difficult but we realize only the truth can save. And true religion is not about following rules or stipulations but a desire of wanting to please the Lord-God because we love him more than life itself and we love others as ourself.

On the other hand, when I traveled around the world, I found all people will adopt the gods of their peers. All will do good works like feeding the hungry or helping the poor. So instead of having people turn to God they play God and by all their works they receive the admiration of men.

So let me present you with a question. Let's say your city burns down to the ground. Would you not want to know the reason God allowed this to happen? Or would you prefer to have people come in and help you to rebuild only to have something worse happen later causing loss of life, etc.?

God for sure doesn't love me more than he loves you. So why would he allow this to happen to you and not to me? Sure, Lot was tried and we are tried in many other ways. One example of being tried is to find out if you believe what Christ taught? Christ taught if you have faith of a mustard seed a mountain could move. He sure didn't mean on top of you.



And I hope you see why it's important to test the spirit a person is led by. For you see those who were led by apostate faiths realized the true apostles baptized people in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. And they convinced people they could do the same thing. However, they were not established by God, and caused those who followed them to receive a spirit that had inhabited those of the Roman Empire. Thus, explaining how they caused the world to worship the first beast calling him God. Which by now you should realize is another spirit. This was in fact the abomination of desolation and how it brought ruin upon the entire world Mt 9:27.

For if you are able to understand what Scripture says: (which some have changed). This verse should actually say: When you shall see the abomination of desolation who stands in place of the Holy then let those who are in Judea flea to the mountains Mk 13:14, Matthew 24: 15,16. So in other words when this is made known we find war in Israel.

Then two thousand years ago when Thessalonians two verses one through twelve was written we were forewarned to be on the lookout for those who proclaimed, the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.



The reason was because the day of the Lord could not come until there had come a falling away from the true faith. And that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition. For he will oppose and exalt himself above all that is called God. Insomuch he shows himself as God.


I mean don't you think the church is the temple of God? Yet Christ said not to call any spiritual leader your father: for one is your Father, which is in heaven Mth 23:9. Our God and Father lives in Heaven and not in some church or in Rome. I mean if he considers himself the father doesn't, he consider himself God?

So, I hope you see so you can escape their judgement, as history reveals when their movement began religion was forced upon all. Eventually it dwarfed into what we see today.

Even during the English Empire everyone was forced to attend church. Their theology was taught in all schools and they indoctrinated all. Many people started fleeing Europe to America claiming it was to seek religious freedom because people could not buy or sell and were forced to worship their gods. However, coming to America, thy plundered the land for its minerals. They preached Jesus, yet killed the indigenous people, and made slaves out of others.

The Judgement





The Man of Sin that was is not yet is

Now we have seen previously how John in his vision explains he saw a woman who was named Mystery Babylon representing a great city sitting on a beast with seven heads. And it was by apostate theology she gained power over the kings of the earth Rev 17:18.

Now for the most part Revelation 13 explained how apostate theology rose causing people to worship another spirit. Whereas Revelation seventeen will explain the mystery of the woman. Who she is and her fate.

But first we have to understand how this judgment unravels.

To find out how this cities destruction comes about we find Scripture informs us: there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space. And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition Rev 17:10.

With the help of a concordance seven kings can also be translated seven kingdoms.

Next what I found is the G7 or that being "The Group of Seven which is an intergovernmental political and economic forum consisting of Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, the United Kingdom and the United States".

Revelation explains five of these kings or kingdoms are fallen. Fallen in this verse means five kings or kingdoms have failed. So, since the fall of the Roman Empire. History reveals out of the G-Seven France, Germany, Italy, Japan, and the United Kingdom failed in war or in establishing themselves as superior. While on the other hand the United States accomplished this feat. Meaning the United States is the Government who is.

Revelation had explained another kingdom would join the seven for a short time. Then as the years past, at the invitation of the G7 leaders, Russian President Boris Yeltsin was invited first as a guest observer, and later as a full participant. After the 1997 meeting, Russia was formally invited to the next meeting and formally joined the group in 1998, resulting in the Group of Eight (G8).

In March 2014 Russia was suspended indefinitely following the annexation of Crimea, whereupon the political forum name reverted to G7. In January 2017, Russia announced its permanent withdrawal from the G8.

So, don't you see? The beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition Rv 17:10.

Thereby this reveals out of the 8th government which is Russia we find the man of sin who corrupted the world. He was, is not, yet is because he is reincarnated unto his judgement. Whereby, They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms; that made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners? Isa 14:16,17.

What next will be revealed is how a city was established by the apostasy. And how this man of sin will align himself with ten other countries causing WWIII.

To do this we will have to look at some history and Scripture will make known the woman whom John saw. We know she is a great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth Rv !7:18. And it is also realized; The waters in Revelation, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues Rv 17:15. Which of course is the world.

Now the United Nations is an intergovernmental organization whose stated purposes are to maintain international peace and security, develop friendly relations among nations, achieve international cooperation, and serve as a center for harmonizing the actions of nations.

Yet it is written, when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape 1 Thes 5 5:3. Over the years governments realized people were unable to always agree. This was because their theology was established by evil and not faith. They realized to stay superior they created a power which became the city that would reign over the world. Whereby NATO was created by 12 countries from Europe and North America on 4 April 1949. Eventually growing to 31 countries.

And to explain how NATO fits in we are told when the second beast rose it would evolve and create an image of the first beast Revelation 13:15. So if you are able to realize the first beast was the Roman Empire which was a country whose people were possessed by an evil spirit. And by their munitions they enforced their rule upon all other populations. Hence an image would consist of the same. And it was given a mouth to speak. Nonetheless the Holy Roman Empire kept its established rule over the church worldwide and America became her footstool.

Nonetheless the beast that was, is not, yet is was released from the bottomless pit. And he knows he hath but a short time Rev 12:12. Thereby hooking up with ten nations who, shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire. For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled Rev 17: 16,17

Then to find the ten horns mentioned in Revelation seventeen I had to realize the ten kings, had received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. Doesn't this mean they give their power unto the man of sin who was, is not, yet is?



Looking at those who are members of the BRICS nations. I was reminded how Daniel mentioned there are eleven horns or that being eleven kingdoms. Does this mean one nation would be the man of sin who was, is not, yet is. The BRICS nations are Brazil, Russia, India, China, South Africa, United Arab Emirates, Iran, Saudia Arabia, Egypt, and Ethiopia.

It is then revealed, the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire, Revelation 17:12. The whore is of course false religions but the woman is the great city being NATO. In other words, WWIII

However, these ten nations will not escape the wrath of this war as Daniel explains three of these countries will be plucked up by their roots.

And notwithstanding the judgment will sit.

And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone Rev 19:20.


Finding Hope in a World gone bad

The tribulation gets so bad they get angry at God and blame those who preach in his name.

However, those who preach the truth will not escape his wrath either. As they will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful, Revelation 17:14.

Nonetheless it is at this time Christ takes back his authority and will prove to the world those who have told the truth. And the way Christ does this is explained in Revelation eleven verses three through thirteen.





The story is true as it reads. And as John explained the Lord will give power unto his two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.

And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.


And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

And after three days and a half, the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them. As they are raptured.

And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.



Once this happens many people will realize these two apostles told the truth and repent. And because our God is love and forgiving, we know the reason John saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God Rev 15:2. Thereby the devil loses and many will come through this great tribulation and be saved.

However, this man of sin will not humble himself but be angry and will open his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven Rev 13:6.

Four Horsemen

The next chapters tend to digress but I want to solidify how all of Scripture reverts back to meaning the same thing. Whereas this chapter will look at four horses that rode forward in Revelation. Each horse and their riders are assigned a color. The color designates what ideology it represents.



White Horse

White represents holy, good, and pure. But he was an imposter.


Then written in Revelation: I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see. And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see. Rev 6:1-3

The white horse riding forth was basically the apostate faiths ridding forth. The apostasy seems to be great as it appears they promise everyone who follows them heaven.

Revelation explains when the apostate religion came forth it was a cunning spirit. A white horse: and the one who sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer Rv 6:2. A white horse also suggests purity and goodness, but it is a deceptive spirit riding forth. And this too was the reason we were warned that it was no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light, 2 Cor 11:14.





History then reveals when apostate religions came forth, they took lands, killing those who wouldn't believe in their God—even plundering new worlds of their gold and other resources. The inquisition was self-righteous and claimed to be pure and above sin and killed everyone else as it claimed those of the world were the heretics. Not following Christ's teaching but used his name to deceive all. Even fighting amongst themselves for hundreds of years.

Whereas, if people had followed what Christ taught, they would uphold his teachings. Christ didn't send his apostles with guns blazing like these importers went forth. So, don't you see, in them, we can find the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth Rv 18:24. In fact, they manipulated people, and committed genocide against the faithful saints. They even dispersed Israel, who was not a nation again for two thousand years. They were the persecutors and like a chameleon they claimed they were the persecuted.

Sure, they claim they are like David in Scripture, who was a man of war. During David's days, the Jews were God's chosen people, and they were fighting for real estate, but we are living in the last days. And a day to God is like a thousand years. When Christ came, he explained God so loved the world not just some nation or denomination. We are to do good unto our enemies being those who may not believe.

For you see, they are imposters posing as ambassadors of Christ, Mt 24: 4-5. They claim they are able to lead people to Christ even though Christ said, wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, Christ is in the desert; go not forth: behold, Christ is in the secret chambers; believe it not, Mt 24:26. Many will say this means a person but if the spirit they are leading you to isn't real, what or who is it?

In fact, Scripture tells us: believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world" 1 Jn 4:1. And to enable you to test a spirit a person is led by, you have to know God is truth and the devil is a liar and the Father of it, Jn 8: 44. For this reason, you can't take verses of Scripture you like and ignore the rest of the Bible. As Jesus explained in Matthew four, verse four, a man shall not live by bread alone but by Every Word of God. And God is not a hypocrite! Whereby He means what he says in every aspect of his Word. Therefore, if verses seem to contradict, pray until you have understanding and get the true meaning.

Second Corinthians eleven explains, apostate faiths would preach another Jesus, causing people to receive another spirit. This was the reason Paul wrote, if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. 2 Co 11:4.

And by not following nor understanding the truth they ask another spirit to enter them. Afterwards they worship the spirit they received as God. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship the beast (evil spirit), whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. If any man has an ear, let him hear Rv 13:8.

Red Horse

Red represents blood, war, and strife.

"And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword" Rv 6:4.

The red horse reveals strife and war. Civil war, WWI, WWII, and the many other wars. As these events are still going on with WWIII around the corner. Christ told us nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: Mt 24:7. Hence power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword, Rv 6:4. Like previously mentioned many will use the story of David in Scripture as he was a man on the battlefield.

Scripture reveals during the days of Nineveh after Lot told them of their judgment, they repented. God had empathy for the city because there was no-one to explain what the Lord-God wanted. Once they repented in old clothing and were remorseful, the Lord spared their city. But since Christ explained what God expected, there are no more excuses. As Christ himself said, "If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin, Jn 15:22.

And to choose this world and real estate over heaven is to be a friend of this world, thereby making you the enemy of God. As stated in James four, Know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God Jms 4:4? Those in Christ strive to enter into heaven, and if we are mindful of the country from whence we come out, otherwise we too might have had opportunity to have joined with this world, Heb 15:15.

Don't you realize, ALL governments use soft imperialism claiming their governments and countries are good. They will have their young men go to war to kill and be killed. If their young men die, they all assume paradise or heaven awaits them. At which point, regardless of what country they fight for, their countrymen will praise them. Don't you see it? We wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places Eph 6:12. Didn't the Roman Empire fight for their country? Didn't the Ottoman Empire do the same? Yet where are they now?



And besides this, if you can comprehend and hear what the Spirit says, there is but one great commandment, and thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, Mk 12:30-31. And there aren't any other commandments more significant than these. So how can you go to war, kill your fellow man and claim to love your fellow man?

The Black Horse

The rider on this horse represents the color black.


And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand, Rv 6:5. The scale designates judgment when this rider rides forth.

These historical movements will bring in the beginning of the great tribulation whereby we find inflation and: A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine Rev 6:6. A penny in this passage is a day's wage so I have to believe it will be so. Whereas it will eventually cost us a day's wage for a loaf of bread.

During this historical movement we find the color black as many Muslim groups like Al Queda, Taliban, And Al Shabab. All of them dress in black, and fly black flags. All of them claim injustice has been committed against them. Some even become suicide killers. They have to think they are fighting for the good, and paradise awaits them.

Years ago, during WW II, the Japanese practiced Hari-Kari, and they too would commit suicide for the sake of their country and injustice committed unto them.





The thing I want you to understand is God is merciful and a murderer can find forgiveness if he repents. However, the thing to note is when you kill yourself, there is no way to regret or repent from it due to you are dead. And if God would judge a person for killing you and he didn't repent. He would judge him harshly. Thereby if you kill yourself, God has to judge you the same way because you would have killed the same person. Namely you! For you see, the God of heaven does not show favoritism; neither is He a hypocrite, as declared in Romans two verse eleven!

And to find this black horse in other parts of the world there is a movement called Black Lives Matter. Many have been taught as youngsters that injustice has been committed against them. I may not have walked in someone else's shoes, and it is not for me to judge. Nor can we deny injustice has been delt to people of color.

So has brutality, tyranny, repression, suppression, exploitation, bigotry, favoritism, partiality, one-sidedness, discrimination, partisanship, intolerance been done to them. Obviously, it has and I believe God has heard these cries.


But what is important to understand is injustice was committed against Christ and the apostles, and they sure didn't make a spectacle of themselves, loot, cause riots, or burn down buildings.

This color is like a person who loses his life and is a pale green color.

And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

Sure, the apostles died at the hands of unbelievers which of course brings the judgment upon the unbeliever.

And the wicked not having any help from the Lord God shall be killed in judgment. War, hunger, and death can be fires, earthquakes, pestilence and such. Not to judge, just report.

Evolution or Creation




I know evolution makes sense to some people, but then that logic falls apart when you consider the earth, humankind, animals, and everything you see. All of this happened by accident as some proclaim. Or, like others, profess people are the ancestry of monkeys who evolved and turned into humanity? Whereas they say human DNA is closely related to a chimpanzee DNA? I mean we know a boy grows into a man as we can witness this. And if evolution were true why did the process stop?

On the other hand, we know God is God, meaning He is supreme and the head of all authority. The Lord God doesn't play politics. Either you love, believe, and follow His teachings, or you don't. He sent Christ to provide a path for us to pursue and testified; "If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love., Jn 15:10."

Once humans were created and placed on earth, the Lord God gave Adam and Eve words to follow as they were commanded not to eat from the forbidden tree of knowledge. Once they disobeyed the Lords commands, they returned to the ground, for out of it they were created, and unto dust they returned, Gn 3:19. Hence they died.

And why was the Tree of Knowledge created if it was not placed there to test their love, dedication, and obedience?





Satan cast out of heaven, and as an evil spirit was cast unto the earth. Since this time, he has been warring with God by deceiving and possessing whom he could. And the reason Satan went about to deceive people was because he realized when God found the appropriate number of people who loved, believed and obeyed Him. Satan knew his end would come.

Nonetheless during the days of Adam and Eve, Satan realized God spoke the truth even if he refused to follow it. But because he recognized the Lord named a tree knowledge, Satan realized it was capable of providing intelligence.

Thereby, "the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die. For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil, Gn 3:4-5. So since the beginning of time Satan uses God's word in a mixed-up fashion promising those who listen to him life.

After Adam and Eve ate from the tree of knowledge, the Lord said "Behold, the man has become as one of us, to know good and evil, Gn 3:22". Whereby the Lord knew humankind would be capable to copy many of His achievements. This is also the reason after humans build the city of Babylon, the Lord said, Behold, the people are one, and they have all one language, and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined doing, Gn 11:6.

In other words, humans were capable of gaining knowledge because Eve influenced by an evil spirit stole the fruit from the tree of knowledge. Thereby, humankind has increased in wisdom and can mimic many of God's achievements and even miracles. And by understanding this, it should be obvious the forbidden tree of knowledge changed humankind's makeup. This change enabled humanity's mind to evolve to the point we see on this day, and they can create medicine, which is for good, and weapons of mass destruction for bad, Gn 2:17.

Nevertheless, when Christ came, he didn't bring medical books but healed people by God's power. Even when Elijah called fire down from heaven, it wasn't fireworks or planes dropping bombs, but God's power 2 Kings 1:10.

As the years progressed, people began to put their trust in so-called science and testified in first Timothy. Eventually, when a person was overcome and possessed by seven spirits, it was thought to be superstitious to believe in spirit possession, and mental illness took its place, Mt 12:43-45. At this point, the world became blind and unaware of this evil spirit's existence and influence.

As science progressed and cured many illnesses faith evaporated. But if you are capable to believe God created the entire world, you would know it was possible for God to plant a tree that was capable of giving knowledge to those who ate its fruit?

But instead, many want to believe a monkey appeared from nowhere and evolved insomuch he could fly to the moon?

Christ's Second Coming

Don't you understand? Those from heaven, look similar to people, yet somehow are different 1 Cor 8:6, 1 Cor 15. After Christ's crucifixion while in the grave he was born again and his body went through a metamorphosis similar to a butterfly. Reborn into a celestial being, he rose from the grave. Thereby his tomb was empty Jn 20:18, and the apostles felt his skin and even ate with him. Luke 24:39.

Scripture tells us: When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne Matthew 25:31". Many UFOs are being seen in this day. How did people think Christ would appear? Did they think Christ would appear like air and a fuzzy feeling because they didn't really believe in his literal existence and that he lives?

However, we know Christ coming is in judgment. And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory, Mt 24:30.

Whereas its written Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age: and he made him a coat of many colors. And when his brethren saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him Gn 37: 3-4

One-night Joseph had a dream of becoming a monarch over the rest of his family. And the second night, Joseph had another similar dream. Reporting his dreams to his family caused his brothers to be envious, and because they were jealous, they hated him more.

One day his brothers were tending to the flock of sheep, when Joseph asked his father where they were.



Joseph recognized them, and after playing a couple of tricks on them. He could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried. He requested all out of the room other than his brothers. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren, Gn 45:1.

Joseph had no animosity towards them, but instead, moved his entire family to Egypt to care for them.

Now when God chose Jacob whom He renamed Israel it was to establish His chosen people, the house of Israel. Jacob had twelve sons, and each son's offspring became a tribe for the house of Israel.

Yet, out of all of Jacob's sons only Joseph showed integrity, love, compassion, and forgiveness for those who had done him wrong.

And the point of this story reveals when Christ came, he chose twelve apostles, one for each tribe of Israel. And one apostle was the of son of perdition. Thereby Christ said: "While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled, Jn 17:12."

Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God; 1 Jn 4:7,8. Don't you see it? If the brothers of Joseph were of God, they would have loved their brother. And there would not have been a reason for Christ to choose eleven apostles at his coming.



Joseph Amongst the Twelve

Apostles Christ testified in Matthew fourteen, if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses, Mt 6:14. In other words, you have to be able to forgive people when they commit acts against you. If you can do this, then God will forgive you.

To forgive doesn't mean you riot in the streets, go to war, and sue others because you got sick after eating something, etc. How can you say you forgive others and take them to court and sue them? Or look at the division in all the countries. If you have a tender heart, why would you be prone to violence, war, rioting, and strife? Christ said unto us, that ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also, Mt 5:39.




Of course, none of us are perfect and we can't claim we only will have perfect children. So, the next story is found in Genesis and it is regarding Joseph. This story reveals how his children failed even though they were from the loins of God's elect.

God had chosen Jacob whom He renamed Israel and from his loins we find he had twelve sons. The years passing and from each son's loins the twelve tribes of Israel were formed.

In other words, Christ on purpose chose an apostle that would sell him out because all of Jacob's sons failed except one, and that was Joseph.

So, like Judas sold out Christ because he was covetous. Joseph's brothers sold him because they were envious.

Thereby, we know in the kingdom of heaven Joseph's name is written in the walls of heaven with the other apostles, And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb, Rv 21:14.



Or again as it is written, "And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for love shall cover the multitude of sins 1 Peter 4:8."

And by this we know, If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also 1 Jn 4:20, 21.

Yet, as Judas sold Christ for money, Joseph's brothers sold him to the Egyptians. Whereby they lost their inheritance in the Kingdom of God. For many are called, but few are chosen Mth 22:14.

"Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law. Rom 13:10"

What about the Children?

We know God is the Word, He is love, yet He cannot lie. In this chapter, we want to investigate if God is love, how could He destroy a world full of people, including children.



Christ explained the days of judgment would be like the days of Noah. Yet we know as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark Mth 24:38. If they were getting married, they had children. Right?

Christ coming will be like the days of Lot, and according to the stories in Scripture, they sure weren't celibate. So, they too were having children. Right?

Even the Old Testament explained when we reached the last days and the judgment comes, even if Noah, Daniel, and Job were alive they would not be able to save a son nor daughter, but they would only be able to save their own souls by their own righteousness, Ezk 14:20.

Then second Peter explains as Noah's days unfolded: The Lord spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly 2 Pt 2:5. Telling us the Lord only saved Noah's soul.

Whereas, First Peter explains there were few, that is, eight souls were saved by water 1 Pt 3:20. Eight people only were rescued from the floods, and no one else!

So, if God is love, and all things are possible for God except to lie! Then how would it have been possible for God to destroy all except Noah's soul from death, and only Noah's families from the flood, and killed the rest, even children?

Now we know the Lord God is not a liar, yet he is loving and forgiving. Nonetheless it is written the Lord destroying cities including the children can be a perplexing puzzle.

And to find how this is possible. You have to realize, "The beginning of wisdom is to fear the Lord Prv 9:10". Additionally, all of Scripture reveals, it is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God Heb 10:31. In other words just because God is good doesn't mean He can be taken advantage of.

First, we know the soul belongs to God, and children are but a loan unto us. If a soul goes to heaven or hell, it belongs to the Lord God. And if a soul sins against the Lord, He will destroy it. I mean if humans created Al and a robot was to fight the humans that created it wouldn't they do the same?

So how is it God could destroy children? To find the reason, we will have to search all of Scripture.

And to begin with we find, when Christ lived amongst us on earth, he said, now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out Jn 21:31. In other words, the beginning of God's Judgment came when Jesus walked upon Earth. During that day, like today, the religions had deceived many people.

Pretentious, we know these false apostles shall not be established in God's kingdom. And the reason for this is because they set themselves up and were not a chosen vessel of the Lords. For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error 2 Pt 2:18 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: 2 Pt 2:29.

These false apostles, not understanding Scripture, think they can hide behind children. As they know, God is love and forgiving, which has caused them to use children for their means. But God in His wisdom knew they would do this. They claim they want to save children and as a pretense are against abortion. Yet the sin is fornication, incest, and rape. And abortion is the fruit of the sin. If you know a tree is infected with a disease, would you focus on the fruit or the disease?

So, in this chapter, we want to find the reason the Lord can judge the entire world, including children. However, you will have to know God is just and He gives every soul a chance. Hence the reason it is written: "it is appointed unto men to die once, but after this the judgment, Heb 9:27". What this verse says is we live one time, die, and are brought back unto the judgment!

When Christ walked amongst Israel, he said now is the judgment Jn 12:31, because he told us what God wanted and expected. This act then brought in the beginning of the end of the world.

So, when Jesus was crucified, it's revealed there were some saints who had already died. Then when Jesus was crucified on the cross "the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; Mt 27:51. And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, Mt 27:52. And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many Mt 27:53.

So those who believed in Christ and lived during that day, died once, but were immediately resurrected because the day of judgment had come.

Those that believe in Christ are not brought back unto condemnation. But it was proving the day of judgment had come. As the apostle explained, it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment, Heb 9:27.

Christ also proved this to be true in another story written in John, whereby Lazarus had died, and Jesus said unto his disciples, Lazarus is dead, Jn 11:14. And I am glad for your sake that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless, let us go unto him Jn 11:15, Then said Thomas, which is called Didymus, unto his fellow disciples, Let us also go, that we may die with him Jn 11:16. Then when Jesus came, he found that he had laid in the grave four days already Jn 11:17.

Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off: Jn 11:18

And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother. Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him: but Mary sat still in the house. Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died Jn 11:19-21.

But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee. Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again. Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believe's in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever lives and believes in me shall never die. Believest thou this?, Jn 11:22- 26.

She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world. And when she had so said, she went her way, and called Mary her sister secretly, saying, The Master is come, and calls for thee. As soon as she heard that, she arose quickly, and came unto him, John 11:26-29.

Now Jesus was not yet come into the town, but was in that place where Martha met him John 11: 30

The Jews then which were with her in the house, and comforted her, when they saw Mary, that she rose up hastily and went out, followed her, saying, She went unto the grave to weep there John 11:31.

Then when Mary was come where Jesus was, and saw him, she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died John 11:32.

When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled. And said, where have ye laid him? They said unto him, Lord, come and see. Jesus wept John 11:33-35.

Then said the Jews, behold how he loved him! And some of them said, could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died? John 11:36-37

Jesus therefore again groaning in himself went to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it John 11:38.

Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinks: for he hath been dead four days. Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou would believe, thou should see the glory of God? John 11:39-40.

Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. And I knew that thou hear me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me. And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. John 11: 41-43.

And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with grave clothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, loose him, and let him go John 11:44.

As Jesus testified, the day of judgment had arrived. Whereby, Lazarus too, died and was brought back from the dead. Proving, the day of judgment had arrived as Christ declared.

Of course, those in Christ don't die a second death as recorded in Revelation twenty verse fourteen. This is because the second death has no power over those who believe in him. Or again as Revelation twenty, verse fourteen, explains the second death is not meant to harm those who have ears to hear and comprehend what Christ taught. which is explained in John five, verse twenty-four.

Furthermore, Christ explained, "The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live, Jn 5:25." Those who had died previous to Christ coming or those in other parts of the world would be resurrected and reincarnated during a time they would have a chance to hear God's Word.

To enable Christ's voice to be heard worldwide was the reason the gospel had to be published in all nations, Mark 13:10.

Reincarnated, you would have died once and are brought back unto the day of judgment.

Whereby if a person died as a child in their first life and had never heard of Christ or what he taught, he would be brought back and given a chance to grow up in his next life. At which point, men directed by God published the Bible, and he, too, was allowed to hear the Lord's words.

Others may have lived in other parts of the world in their first life and never had a chance to hear his word and they too are brought back and given an opportunity once the Bible was published.

But as it was revealed it was a narrow gate into God's Kingdom. Many people were more concerned about the cares of this life like the deceitfulness of riches and the lust of other things. Many may have just refused to believe what Christ taught, and they will go through tribulations as explained in the previous chapter.

This also was the reason Christ told us in Mark fourteen, verse sixty-two the high priest would see Jesus "sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven, Mark 14:62." Christ sitting on the right hand of God means Christ is God's number one man. Just as you use your right hand for all things, Christ is the person God uses. Thereby, we know when Jesus comes in God's power, the high priest that lived in Christ's day shall be reincarnated and witness his second coming.

And on top of all that, it had been prophesied that the Lord would send Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord. Malachi 4:5.

One day when Christ was speaking of John the Baptist it was written that he told us that the law prophesied until John has always suffered violence But he also claimed, if ye will receive it, this is Elias, which was to come, Mt 11:14. Hence revealing Elijah had been reincarnated.

We know the judgment will culminate in Christ appearing in the heavens and the gate into the Kingdom of God shall be closed. Yet as revealed, Christ still prayed for those who didn't believe in him, saying: "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do," Lk 23:34.

Again, God is love, but He is not a liar. Nor does he show favoritism as He is not a respecter of persons. And many won't be granted a seat in God's Kingdom but can still inherit the new world if they repent.

We know, in this day, some people are spiritually possessed and are unable to comprehend anything. But because I know God is good and God is love if a person lived a previous life and was despicable toward God's Spirit. Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men Mt 12:31. Or was this person actually one of the angels who had been cast out of heaven?

I can't be certain as it's not for me to judge but to believe. I can't see a person's heart, but I know God is good and God is love. And those who have chosen Satan will not sneak much less be coerced into anything.

And of course, those who chose Satan's spirit, causing others to worship him and called him their God, have chosen death. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death., Rv 20:14.

The Judgment of Babylon the Great

And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters: Rv 17:1

With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication. Rv 17:2

So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. Rv 17:3

WWIII and one judgment that rises is out of the bottomless pit which brings forth some sort of bug or bacteria: Revelation explains this bug will not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads Rv 9:4.

And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them, Rv 9:6.

For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off Revelation 18:17,

And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like unto this great city Revelation 18:18!

And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate Revelation 18:19.

Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged you on her Revelation 18:20

And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all Revelation 18:21

And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft he be, shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee Revelation 18:22.

And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived Revelation 18:23

And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth Revelation 18:24
