Dictionary of Uses for Neo-Life Green

Full Strength Uses

Baby bath or bubble bath: Squirt 1 oz. under full stream in tub...luxury suds!

Baby clothes: 1/2 tsp. in basin of water.

Burns: (see First Aid)

Dentures: A few drops in warm water. Soaks clean and deodorizes.

Delicate fabrics: 1/2 to 1 tsp in a basin of water (cool for wool and most synthetics) gently work through fabric, rinse. Dry as per manufacturer's directions.

Fruits and Vegetables: A few drops in basin of cool water removes soil and insecticide residue. Allow to soak for a short time, agitate gently, and rinse.

Insect bites: Pat on gently, let dry...stops itch.

Invisible glove: Prior to gardening, painting, machine repair apply to hands, run in gently, let dry. Paint, grease, oil, dirt will slip away during washup.

Poison ivy/ oak: Pat on gently...do not rub...let dry. Reapply as needed. Stops itch and spread of irritation.

Shaving: Wet face, use few drops; work into lather. Gives smooth comfortable shave. Variation: Mix 1 oz. NCB to 7 oz Green in 8 oz dispenser bottle. Apply as above. Makes "wetter" shave.

Theatrical makeup: (See invisible glove.)

Woolens and all delicate fabrics: 1/2 to 1 tsp. in a basin of water (cool for wool and most synthetics) gently work through fabric, rinse. Dry as per manufacturer's directions.

Utility Mix

(1/2 Green-1/2 water, in dispenser bottle)

Bath/ Shower: Use in place of soap...a small squirt in hand works into luxurious suds.

Eyeglasses: A drop on each lens surface, rub, rinse, dry.

Hands/face: for general washing needs. Do not wet skin first. Squirt small amount into palm, work into lather, add water, massage, rinse.

Pets: wet fur, apply first around neck, then use sparingly all over animal, work into lather, rinse thoroughly. Naturally deodorizes.

Shampoo: Wet hair, squirt small amount into palm of hand, work into hair. Be sure to lather twice. Rinse thoroughly each time.
