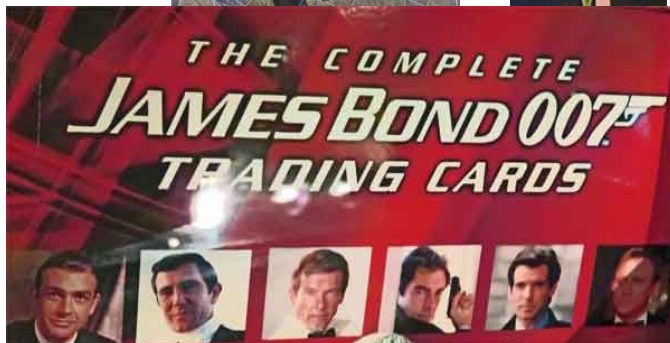
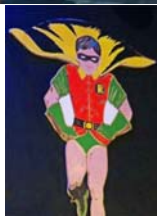




Dezer Collection: Part 3 Hollywood Car Collection

In 1954, Barry Nielsen played Bond in a TV series called "Climax!". It was an adaptation of Ian Fleming's Casino Royale. The 007 movies began with Sean Connery in 1962. Connery played Bond seven times (1962-67, 1971 and 1983). His first movie was a blockbuster called "Dr. No." Other movies were: "From Russia with Love," "Goldfinger," "Thunderball," "You Only Live Twice," "Diamonds Are Forever," and "Never Say Never Again." Roger Moore, 1972-1985, "Live and Let Die," "Moonraker," "A View to a Kill," "The Man with the Golden Gun," "Octopussy," "For Your Eyes Only" and "The Spy Who Loved Me." Timothy Dalton, 1995-2004, "Golden Eye," "Tomorrow Never Dies," "The World is Not Enough," and "Die another Day." Daniel Craig, 2005-- "Casino Royale," "Quantum of Solace," "Skyfall," and "Spectre." George Lazenby played Bond in 1969 movie called "On Her Majesty's Secret Service."
