

This is from one block of marble!

Il Disinganno, also known as *The Release from Deception*, was crafted by Genoese artist Francesco Queirolo in the 18th century. Widely regarded as his *masterpiece*, this sculpture has solidified Queirolo's legacy as one of Italy's leading 18th-century artists. It reportedly took Queirolo seven years to fabricate this marble net, which he crafted without a workshop, apprentice, or any other form of external assistance. Mainly because sculptors "refused to



touch the delicate net in case it broke into pieces in their hands."


