Dear GVUSD Families,

Golden Valley Unified School District believes in educating every child. We have offered as many program options as possible, in an attempt to meet the needs and desires of our students and their families, during the COVID Pandemic.

GVUSD is required to enforce masking in schools as required by the Governor's mandate. This will continue until the mandate changes, the current state of emergency is lifted, or the law changes. However, this enforcement will be within the parameters of Ed. Code.

All sites will follow these procedures for students who do not wear a mask.

- 1. If a student comes to school without a mask, we will provide them with a mask and ask them to put it on.
- 2. If the student continues to not wear a mask, staff will note that a mask was given and the student was asked to put it on. This is so that site administrators can follow up with parents in a phone call.
- 3. Site administrators will call home to explain the mandate, answer any questions, and provide possible options.

Students will not be removed from class, as this would be outside of the law and doesn't fit with our goal of providing a top notch education to every student.
