



## 1. KEY DATA

**Aim of the project:** Empowerment and Participation of the African Diaspora in NRW, Strengthening Participation in Societal Design Processes in the Local Social Area through Networking and Professionalization the Model Regions of Dortmund, Düsseldorf and Cologne

## 2. PROCEDURES

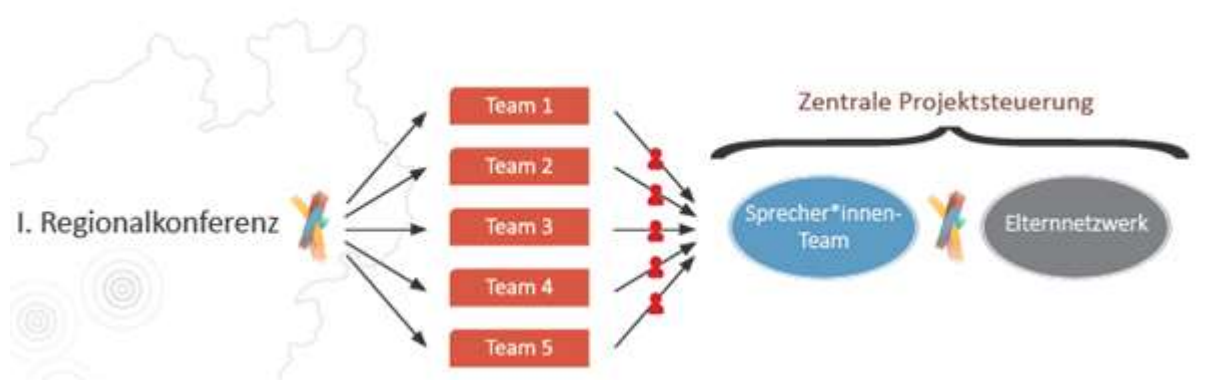
**Regional Conferences I:** Regional conferences will take place in the three model regions by the summer of 2018. The focus is on the fields of action of the association's work, the strengthening of resources and the networking in the areas. There will be five workshops with emphasis on the central fields of action of the association's work. In addition, an anonymous survey will be conducted in order to gain more information about the life situation of the African Diaspora in Germany, their experiences with racism and their work in the association.

**Local teams and speaker team:** Based on the conferences, five local teams (8-12 members) shall emerge from each of the five workshops in each region. They shall meet once a month, in turn in the Associations meeting places and continue to work self organized on the selected topics. The teams shall develop joint action strategies and perspectives. Existing initiatives and offers should be recognized and supported. Each team will select one speaker from its members. The speakers will then form a speaker's team in each of the three regions. The team shall direct the strategic networking of Association.

**Central Project Management:** The parent network (Elternnetzwerk NRW e.V.) and one member each from the local speaker's team shall manage the project. At the end of the project, the results of the work of the local teams will be presented to the interested public in the form of a second series of

regional conferences. It will also discuss within this framework about the sustainable structures of the project.

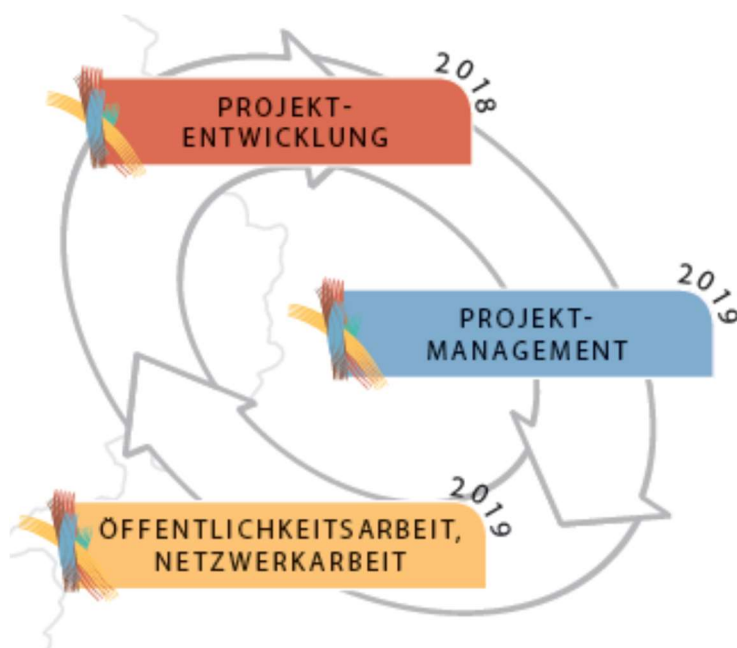
**Regional Conferences II:** At the end of the project the outcomes of the local teams should be presented in another conferences in the regions.



3. **MODULAR QUALIFICATION 2018-2019:** Parallel to the work in the local teams, free modular training in project management will be offered in all model regions. The aim is to increase the number of project applications and thus gain more resources for their own work.
