An agenda for the annual meeting will be available on the CAA website www.colaquaa.org by mid December 2019.

The meeting format will be similar to previous years with the 2020 annual meeting and presentations on Friday Jan. 31st followed by a hospitality hour and CAA sponsored dinner Friday evening. The CAA membership business meeting will be held on Saturday morning Feb. 1st. **All members are invited and encouraged to attend the Saturday meeting.** All events will be held in the Conference Center (on the hill by Cliffside Rooms).

For the Friday Jan. 31st meeting, there will be a **\$35 fee for non-members** staying for the hospitality hour and dinner. Note that non-members may want to consider joining CAA (annual dues are \$75/year for active members) to learn more about the aquaculture industry in Colorado. Family members are also welcome for dinner at a cost of \$35/adult. The \$35 fee for dinner for non-members will be payable to CAA at the meeting. **Please RSVP by Jan. 24th** to Tami at tami@aquaticsassociates.com or (970)493-2626 in order to accommodate non-members for dinner.

Lodging: Rooms will be available to meeting attendees at Cliffside (near Conference Center) at a discounted rate. Our 2020 cost for Cliffside rooms is \$150/night total (\$140/night + 7.3% lodging tax), which includes admission to the pools and hot springs. Please call the Resort at (888)395-7799 to book your room as early as possible and **must mention Group Lodging Code COAQ20** to get rooms at CAA's discounted rate. Note that we have a block of 12 rooms on temporary reserve and once these are sold out there are no more rooms available on either Friday or Saturday night. **The deadline for booking rooms is Friday January 10, 2020 by 5 pm.**

Lunch will be available in the restaurant on Friday Jan. 31st. Options include either the lunch special or ordering from the lunch menu at a cost of ~\$12-\$15/person plus tax and gratuity. Lunch must be paid by cash or credit card (not charged to room).

Breakfast will be in the Conference Center (not restaurant) on Saturday Feb. 1st starting at 7:30 am before the membership business meeting which starts at 8:30 am. The simple breakfast menu will include muffins, scones, fresh fruit, yogurt, juice, coffee and tea. The cost is \$5/person including tax and gratuity, and will be paid by cash at the breakfast.

For anyone not attending the 8:30 am business meeting, the restaurant opens at 8:00 am for breakfast ordered from their regular menu, which would be paid either by cash/credit card or billed to room.
