

## TOP TEN Reasons to use Wire vs. "Wireless Only"

- 1) Ask yourself, are products getting more or less complex?
- 2) Is interaction with products increasing or decreasing?
- 3) Are streaming services increasing or decreasing their resolution?
- 4) Is [potentially harmful] RF increasing around you more or less than 3 years ago? Similar, are wireless products emitting stronger signals than 3 years ago?
- 5) Are homes being built closer to each other more than 15 years ago (increased chance of RF interference between products and increased RF exposure)
- 6) Would anyone argue that accuracy increases with the elimination of wiring? Wireless has increased noise and data error over wired products and is sometimes compressed
- 7) Wireless has limited bandwidth...2 lane highway vs. 6 lanes; do you have more or less wireless devices in your home than 5 years ago?
- 8) If you are recording using wireless, you increase the risk of including buffering into your recording and/or possibly incomplete recordings
- 9) 95% of all data breaches happen in wireless environments
- 10) If wireless is that good, why would any manufacturer continue making wire?
- ~Wireless should be used as a "convenience" or "last resort"...not as the default~
