



Example of a Day at Sleek Academy

TIME	TASK	SPECIALS OF THE DAY
7:30	<p>Start of Day - Students start their day writing a daily quote. They practice printing and cursive writing skills. Older students write a response, in their own words, to the chosen quote. Afterwards, students go outside to raise the school flag and say the Pledge of Allegiance.</p>	<p>Monday: Music Tuesday: Social Emotional Circle Wednesday: Physical Education Thursday: Latin Language Friday: Tinker Time</p>
8:00	<p>Morning Routine - Review the daily calendar, the day's weather conditions and distribute job payments. Each student has an assigned job for each week, ranging from line leader to the lunch sweeper. Students learn about earning and counting money, as well as learning responsibility.</p>	
8:30	<p>Mrs. Abby's Computer Class - Students learn about computers, which includes typing, coding, video editing and more.</p>	
9:00	<p>Theme of the Week Activity</p>	
9:30-10:30	<p>Grade Specific Projects - Each grade level follows their own curriculum plan, mastering skills in English, Math, Science, and Social Studies that are not covered in the larger group projects.</p>	
10:30	<p>Special of the Day (shown to the right)</p>	
11:00	<p>Lunch</p>	
11:30	<p>Outdoor Recess</p>	
12:00	<p>D.E.A.R. (Drop Everything And Read)</p>	
12:30	<p>Writing/Spelling Centers</p>	
1:00-1:30	<p>Group Project - Group tasks are project based, allowing the students to complete assignments that are authentic and engaging. Students work for extended periods of time for several weeks, gaining knowledge and investigating complex questions and challenges. For example, students built a walipini, which used measuring, budgeting and agricultural (plant growing) skills.</p>	
2:00	<p>Wrap Up - Finish group project for the day. Take flag down.</p>
