- This show is a qualifier for the APHS Foreign Breeds National Finals, held on 6th October 2024 at Pickering Grange EC, Leics. Top 3 from each Foreign Breed class qualifies.
- This show is a qualifier for the APHS Ridden Youth Finals, held on 8th September 2024 at APHS London Counties, Surrey. The top 3 from all Junior classes qualify, plus the highest placed Junior in the Novice Ridden & FB Ridden Snaffle class.
- This show is a qualifier for the APHS Veteran Finalé, held on 8th September 2024 at APHS London Counties, Surrey. The top 3 from all APHS Veteran classes during 2024 qualify. It is also a qualifier for the APHS Foreign Breeds Veteran Championships held at the APHS Foreign Breeds National Finals held on 6th October.
- This show is a qualifier for the APHS Champion of Champions, held on 8th September 2024 at APHS London Counties, Surrey. All Champions, Reserves, Second Reserves and Amateur Champions qualify.
- This show is a qualifier for the APHS & Horse Trust Best Body Condition Championship, held on 8th September 2024at APHS London Counties, Surrey. All recipients of a Horse Trust Rosette, APHS Fit not Fat Rosette or Award qualify.

- Class 1. Foreign Breed Lightweight/Refined Types In Hand, any age or sex. Open to types such as Arabs, Morgans, Saddlebreds, Standardbreds, Warmbloods, ASPC, AMHA etc. depending on build. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
- Class 2. Iberian In Hand, any age or sex (includes PRMe). Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
- Class 3. Friesians, Baroque Pintos & Warlanders In Hand, any age or sex (includes PRMe). Friesians will be pinned separately to Baroque Pintos & Warlanders if sufficient entries.
- Class 4. USA Breeds In Hand, any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. Open to any north American breed Morgans, Saddlebreds, QH, Paints, Standardbreds, RMH, Appaloosas etc. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. A special award on offer for the Best Partbred American Saddlebred.
- Class 5. Foreign Breed Middle/Heavyweights In Hand, any age or sex. Open to types such as Morgans, QH, Iberian, Warwmbloods, Paints, Appaloosas, RMH, ASPC, AMHA etc. depending on build. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
- Class 6. Arabs In Hand, any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.

 Winner qualifies for the APHS Foreign Breed National Finals.
- Class 7. Foreign Breeds Geldings In Hand, any age. Purebreds will be pinned separately to

 Partbreds. A Horse Trust Best Body Condition rosette & an APHS Fit not Fat rosette (sponsored by Emma Taylor)

 will be presented in this class. APHS Fit not Fat cards awarded to both please keep the cards safe as you will need them for the APHS & Horse Trust Best Body Condition Championships in September.

- Class 8. Foreign Breed Youngstock In Hand, 3 years or under, any sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. A Horse Trust Best Body Condition rosette & an APHS Fit not Fat rosette (sponsored by Emma Taylor) will be presented in this class. APHS Fit not Fat cards awarded to both please keep the cards safe as you will need them for the APHS & Horse Trust Best Body Condition Championships in September.
- Class 9. Foreign Breed Veterans In Hand, 15 years or over, open to both pure and partbreds. APHS Veteran Finale Qualifier & APHS Foreign Breeds Veteran Championship (for the top 3). A Horse Trust Best Body Condition rosette & an APHS Fit not Fat rosette (sponsored by Emma Taylor) will be presented in this class. APHS Fit not Fat cards awarded to both please keep the cards safeas you will need them for the APHS & Horse Trust Best Body Condition Championships in September.
- Class 10. Foreign Breeds Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown In Hand, any age or sex, open to both pure and partbreds.

 Manners a major consideration in this class and count for 50% of the overall marks. A Horse Trust Best Body
 Condition rosette & an APHS Fit not Fat rosette (sponsored by Emma Taylor) will be presented in this class. APHS

- Class 11. Foreign Breeds Mares & Fillies In Hand, any age. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. A Horse Trust Best Body Condition rosette & an APHS Fit not Fat rosette (sponsored by Emma Taylor) will be presented in this class. APHS Fit not Fat cards awarded to both please keep the cards safe as you will need them for the APHS & Horse Trust Best Body Condition Championships in September.
- Class 12. Foreign Breeds Stallions & Colts In Hand, any age. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. A Horse Trust Best Body Condition rosette & an APHS Fit not Fat rosette (sponsored by Emma Taylor) will be presented in this class. APHS Fit not Fat cards awarded to both please keep the cards safe as you will need them for the APHS & Horse Trust Best Body Condition Championships in September.

FOREIGN BREEDS IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP: For 1st & 2nd in classes 1 to 12. Championship rosettes to Champion, Reserve & Second Reserve. Additional Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown Championship Award. Please wear a white armband in the championships if you are eligible (award will be presented in both the purebred and the partbred championships). Purebreds & Partbreds will have their own separate in hand championship.

Class 13. In Hand Youth Handler (open to any breed, mares and geldings only), handler to be 14 years & under. The horse/pony is merely a prop and conformation will NOT be judged, unless it impinges on the horses way of going. Keepsake trophy for the winner. £10 entry fee for this class.

Ring 1 CLASSES 14 – 19: OPEN TO ANY BREED (not just foreign breeds). Enter the ring at walk on the left rein & proceed as directed by the judge. Any tack is permissible, including trainingtack and horses may be led (off the noseband). Conformation will not be considered in classes (14,15, 16 or 19) UNLESS it impinges on the horses' way of going.

- Class 14. Youth Walk/Trot, riders aged 14 years & under. Lead Lines welcome. Keepsake trophy for the winner. Top 3 qualify for our Junior Ridden Finals in September. £10 entry fee for this class.
- Class 15. Open Walk/Trot, riders any age. Lead Lines welcome. Keepsake trophy for the winner. £10 entry fee for this class.
- Class 16. Intermediate canter riders any age, open to any breed of horse/pony. No individual show and canter only asked for one at a time on the right rein. Aimed as a progression class for those moving between walk/trot andopen classes, who may not yet be ready to canter as a group.
- Class 17. Novice Ridden riders any age. No individual show. Open to any breed of horse/pony. Never to have won a ridden class (prior to 1st Jan 2024) junior riders exempt from this rule .Best Rider 14 years &under qualify for our Junior Ridden Finals in September.

- Class 18. Open Ridden Class, riders may be of any age. Open to any breed of horse/pony. Will be expected to walk, trotand canter. No individual show.
- Class 19. Champagne Class, riders may be of any age. Open to any breed of horse/pony. Will be expected to walk, trot and canter. No individual show. You hold a glass of wine in one hand, and your reins in the other and perform the gaits as called out by the judge. The one with the most wine left in their glass at the end of the class is the winner. This is a fun class. *Entry fee for this class £10*.

OPEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP: All those placing first and second in classes 14 to 18. Championship rosettes to Champion, Reserve & Second Reserve. Additional Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown Championship Award.

- Class 20. Ridden Foreign Breeds Home Produced. Open to both pure and partbreds. To be kept at home, at grass or on DIY livery/Part Livery (min 5 days a week).
- **Class 21. Ridden Foreign Breeds Young Horse** 4 to 8 years old. Open to both pure and partbreds.
- Class 22. Ridden Foreign Breeds Snaffle Bit. Open to pure and partbreds, ridden in a snaffle, bosal or bitless. Best Junior (14 years & under) qualifies for the APHS Junior Ridden Finals in September.
- Class 23. Ridden Foreign Breed Traditional Tack & Parade Spanish, Portuguese, Saddle Seat, Western, Side Saddle etc.

 Judged 50% on Tack/Turnout, 50% on performance. Please enter the ring on the left rein. When "parading" your horse, please come off the rail. Do NOT change rein until requested by the judge. Open to both pure and partbreds.
- **Class 24. Ridden USA Breeds.** Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
- **Class 25. Ridden Foreign Breed Masters.** Open to pure and partbreds, riders to be aged 50 years & over. Manners will be taken into account for this class.
- Class 26. Ridden Foreign Breeds Veteran Horse to be aged 15 years or older. APHS Veteran Final Championship Qualifier & APHS Foreign Breeds Veteran Championship qualifier (top 3).
- Class 27. Ridden Iberian. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. May be shown in Traditional or English Tack.
- Class 28. Ridden Friesians, Baroque Pintos & Warlanders. Friesians will be pinned separately to Baroque Pintos & Warlanders if sufficient entries.
- Class 29. Ridden Foreign Breeds Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown Manners are a major consideration in this class.

 Open to both pure and partbreds.
- Class 30. Ridden Arabs. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbred
- **Class 31. Ridden Foreign Breeds Mares.** Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
- Class 32. Ridden Foreign Breeds Geldings. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds
- Class 33. Ridden Foreign Breeds Stallions Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbred





The SMALL PRINT!

Foreign Breeds – any breed that is non-indigenous to GB, Northern Ireland & Eire (e.g. Irishhorses are NOT eligible, unless they are partbreds crossed with a Foreign Breed). Warmbloods ARE eligible to take part in foreign breed classes.





- held on 6th October 2024 at Pickering Grange, Ellistwon, Leics. Horses only need to qualify to take part in the Foreign Breeds Horse of the Year classes at this event – for other classes at this event NO qualification is needed. Only ONE qualification card is needed per horse, not one per class.
- All foreign breed classes at all our events will be judged under APHS Foreign Breed Show Rules, American style (available on our website www.aphs.org.uk
- The judge will not ride in any class. Individual shows are NOT required in the Foreign Breed classes at any of our events.
- Stallions and colts welcome but should be bitted and under control and to be shown by adults. N.B. Stock horses may be shown in astock halter with a properly secured chain; Iberian horses in a serrata (with a throat lash); Arabs & Miniatures in a show halter etc. –including stallions – BUT they must be under control. The judge, steward, or any show official may excuse a horse from the ring if they deem the handler does not have full control, or if they feel they are of danger to other exhibitors, or they can request that the horse is bitted for subsequent classes.
- Refunds are not given without a doctors or vets certificate please note any PayPal, bank or Stripe fees will be deducted from refunds. If we have to cancel, then full refunds will be given (less admin fees see above) or credit for future APHS events or the option of transferring entries to a future APHS event.
- All, or parts of our events, are outdoors (e.g. London Counties is all outdoors, the Northern show, South-West Show & Foreign Breeds National Finals venue has some rings/warm up outdoors). Exhibitors therefore accept that the weather, climate and temperature, which are out of our control, are an integral partof your experience and may impact on your visit. While we will make every effort to adhere to the printed schedule, we reserve the right to stop or start the show as necessary. If a show is cancelled (by us, the Organisers) because of weather, you will be entitled to exchange your class ticket(s) for another APHS event (spaces permitting).
- All Veteran classes are qualifiers for the APHS Veteran Finalé, held at our London Counties Show top 3 in all veteran classesqualify (cards can be passed down the line, to 6th place, if horses have already qualified).
- All Foreign Breed Veteran classes are also qualifiers for the APHS Foreign Breeds Veteran Championship, held at our APHS Foreign Breed National Finals – top 3 in all foreign breed veteran classes qualify (cards can be passed down the line, to 6th place, if horses have already qualified).
- All youth classes are qualifiers for the APHS Youth Ridden Championship, held at our London Counties Show top 3 in all youth classes qualify (cards can be passed down the line, to 6th place, if horses have already qualified).
- OPEN classes are open to ANY breed of horse/pony (not restricted to Foreign Breeds)
- Timings: allow approx. 15 mins a class for Walk/Trot classes, 15/20 mins a class for Foreign Breed classes and 30 mins a class for Open Breed classes. Please keep an eye on your rings. It is YOUR responsibility to be in time for your class. If you MISS a class, we will not issue a refund.
- Ridden classes horses or ponies in ridden classes must be at least 4 years of age.
- Ponies/Horses being led in the walk/trot and youth classes (where allowed) MUST be led off the noseband. Lead line welcome in anyWalk/Trot or Concours classes, or where the schedule states. If in doubt, please get in contact and
- Training tack can comprise of martingales or Market Harlborough (used on a snaffle rein), flash/grackle noseband (used with asnaffle bit).
- Home Produced kept at home or on DIY/Part-Livery yard and not to have been in training with a professional (except for being sentaway to be backed/broken to harness) for the past 12 months or produced/shown by a professional in the past 12 months: Taking part in clinics /having lessons does NOT exclude you from this division.
- AOTS amateur owned, trained and shown. Owners/Exhibitors not to make any earnings from the horse training or production industry (does not include working as a groom / stable hand UNLESS part of your job is to show said horses). Taking part in clinics /having lessons does NOT exclude you from this division.
- NOVICE not to have come 1st or 2nd at County Show / Breed Show (or equivalent) or competed and placed at RIHS or HOYS duringthe past 2 showing years (e.g., 2022 & 2023 for the 2024 showing season).
- ANY BREED class is open to any breed, pure, part, unregistered or unknown, provided horse meets criteria of the
- Whiskers we recommend that horses/ponies sensory whiskers are not removed for cosmetic reasons. Horses should be turned out correct for their breed (with full mane & tail if correct), in all classes.
- Only the prescribed show rings and show warm up areas should be used. Other areas on the showground must not be used (stable yards, cross country tracks etc.).



- APHS London Counties rings are on grass.
- Current Safety Hats MUST be always worn when mounted. Junior exhibitors (under 18) MUST wear these hats in ALL classes, including in hand. Adult riders should ensure that the Secretary is in possession of a Disclaimer Form for any non-safety conformingheadgear that they choose to wear. A copy of the required wording is shown within. Exhibitors may wear approved safety hats (& jackets) in any class without penalty. Entering online or electronically indicates acceptance of ALL show and venue rules.
- No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants, or horses in connection with or arising out of the show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Promoters against any legal action arising out of any incident and to agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the show and the Showground.
- All competitors must have adequate insurance to cover any incident that may be caused by them or their animals.
- Dogs welcome at Pachesham Equestrian Centre but must be kept on a lead please clear up after your pooch! White Horse Farm hasloose dogs on site, so please leave your dog at home or in your trailer/lorry (if safe to do so). Dogs welcome at Croft Top but must be kept in a lead and are not allowed in the indoor arena or the eating areas.
- Although every effort will be made to adhere to the printed schedule, the Organisers reserve the right to combine, cancel or changethe running order of classes on the day or implement a change of judges if the needs arise and to refuse entry (to competitors, spectators, or their guests) without specifying the reason.
- Please note that all rings run concurrently and so classes MAY clash bear this in mind when making your entries & please watch your rings. It is the policy of this show NOT to forward trophies (where presented) by post, so please check at the Secretary's Desk before going home.
- All competitors must complete and sign an entry form (including contact address) and if needed a Track & Trace
 form. Entering online or electronically indicates acceptance of ALL show and venue rules and will be considered an
 electronic signature.
- <u>DATA COLLECTION:</u> By entering this event you are agreeing for your details to be held on file (to be used to contact you for return oftrophies and details of next year's event and similar events we may think be of interest to you). In addition, you are agreeing for the Organisers to use any photos posted by yourself on our Facebook Group or Page to promote this and future events, and any photo taken by the official show photographers to be used for the same. - Do NOT empty trailer / lorry or muck onto the showground. Please clear obvious hay/poo piles by your lorries and trailers.

 contact withindividuals who are known or suspected to have Covid-19. Or any other infectious disease (horse or
 human).
- Horses attending must also be free from and not have contact with any other horses with any infectious diseases.
