ENTRY: Entrants may enter up to three (3) works for \$10.00 per entry

Membership must be current Entry fees are non-refundable

REGISTRATION: Artwork must be delivered in person to ALB 110 W. Texas Ave

Submissions are Tuesday April 9th and Wednesday April 10th 11am-5pm Absolutely no entries will be accepted after Wednesday April 10th 5pm

RULES: ALB may reject any work of art that does not meet rules of show

All work must have been completed in the last two years except theme art

No controversial subjects such as nudes, politics or the occult

Work must be originally created in concept and design

Photographs or pictures may be used for reference but not copied

No prints of copies of original work will be accepted

No patterns, kits or models may be used except casting of your own work

using the skills you have learned in a class

PICK-UP: All entries should be picked up by Thursday May 9, 2024

DIVISIONS: BEGINNER/INTERMEDIATE: Artists working in any media up to three

years with few sales and/or sales at prices minimally above supply costs

ADVANCED: Artists who have been working in any media more than three years and have had sales significantly above supply costs and/or

1st, 2nd, or 3rd place wins in the INTERMEDIATE division

PROFESSIONAL: Teachers and artists who are paid for art as a profession, artists with regular sales considerably over supply costs, or

artists who have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rs in the ADVANCED Division in any

Art League or City sponsored show

CATEGORIES: NUG (Not Under Glass) 2-D work without protection from glass or acrylic

UG (Under Glass) 2-D work with protection from glass or acrylic other than photography

PHOTOGRAPHY: black/white, color, or digitally enhanced photographs

3D: free standing or hanging intended to be seen from all angles

THEME ART: Open interpretation in any media that has local inspiration done in the past. No time limit but never shown at an ALB member show Entry limit is one piece

SPECIFICATIONS: All work must be installation ready

2-D work should be properly wired (no sawtooth), framed, or wrapped

NUG paintings should be framed or wrapped

UG and PHOTOGRAPHY should be framed under glass or acrylic, unless

the photograph is printed on metal or acrylic

Work that is 28"x32" or larger must be framed with acrylic to prevent

exceedingly heavy weight.

No work exceeding 4'x4' will be accepted

3D work will be displayed on tables or pedestals unless the artist chooses

to supply their own display feature

Sculpture may not exceed 72" in any direction/easily moved by two people

Art League of Baytown will not be responsible for any damage

experienced during installations or removal
